- 3 WHEREAS, "National History Day" (NHD) is an American academic
- 4 competition focusing on history, which began in April 1974 at Case Western Reserve
- 5 University in Cleveland, Ohio. The idea came from history professor David Van

1 Tassel, who was worried about the decline of the humanities, in general, and of

2 history in America's schools; and he wanted to reinvigorate the teaching and learning

3 of history; and

WHEREAS, in every U.S. state, the District of Columbia, Guam, American Samoa, and international affiliates in several other countries, NHD contestants have gone on to become writers, filmmakers, web designers and artists, as they create their own contemporary expressions of history. NHD is a learning experience that teaches critical thinking, writing, and research skills; and it boosts scholastic performance across all subjects – not just history; and

WHEREAS, NHD is a non-profit educational organization that offers year long academic programs that engage over half a million middle and high school students around the world annually in conducting original research on historical topics. NHD also seeks to improve the quality of history education by providing professional development opportunities and curriculum material for educators; and

WHEREAS, on February 28, 2015, Lazaro Quinata and Juan San Nicolas of Father Dueñas Memorial School (FDMS) placed first at the island-wide Guam History Day Contest, which qualified them for entering the 2015 "National History Day" Competition held in Washington, D.C.; and

WHEREAS, Lazaro and Juan created a ten minute video documentary entitled, "The 9<sup>th</sup> Guam Congress: Catalyzing Change, Revolutionizing Politics." The video documentary centered on the 9<sup>th</sup> Guam Congress, with a special focus on the infamous Guam Congress Walkout of 1949. The Guam Congress was first established in 1917 by the Naval Governor at the time, Roy C. Smith. The primary role of the Guam Congress was to serve as an advisory board to the Naval Governor, and they were not given any power to create and amend laws; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Naval occupation of Guam did pave the way for some improvements, and other amenities for the island; but under the Naval Government, various mandates, known as the Naval Executive Orders, restricted many of the rights of the Chamorro people. Most mandates were necessary for the regulation of island affairs, but some proved to infringe on individual civil rights. In 1948, the 9<sup>th</sup> Guam Congress took office; and in 1949, due to the continued lack of national support in Guam's quest for civil governance, they would collectively agree to walk out during its legislative session in open protest against the Naval Government. This historic event served as a catalyst that contributed to the passage of the Organic Act of 1950; and WHEREAS, Juan San Nicolas' and Lazaro Quinata's entry placed third (3<sup>rd</sup>) in the Senior Group Division Documentary category of the 2015 "National History Day" 12 Competition, where there were approximately one hundred entries from a total of fifty-seven (57) states and international affiliates. Their third (3<sup>rd</sup>) place finish is the 14 highest any team from Guam thus far has ever placed since the augment of the 15 16 program eight years ago; now therefore, be it RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of I Mina'Trentai Tres Na 17 18 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the people 19
