1 **WHEREAS,** Dr. Robinson chose Guam as the community he would serve, in 2 spite of the fact that his professional training as a Family Practice Physician qualifies 3 him to serve anywhere in the United States where he could generate more income for 4 him and his family; and 5 WHEREAS, Dr. Robinson chose Guam, an underserved and far-flung area, to 6 7

humbly serve the people of Guam not only with the best quality care but also with sincere compassion and deep understanding of the island's unique culture that is vastly different from his background; and

WHEREAS, by choosing Guam, Dr. Robinson fulfilled his childhood goal of helping the poor, the vulnerable, and the needy by providing medical care as a doctor in an underserved area such as Guam; and

WHEREAS, throughout the duration of the nearly two decades of his practice in Guam, he served with joy not only the patients that came to the Guam clinic and the Guam Memorial Hospital, but counted it as more of a joy to render services to the many people who could not pay for their medical treatments; and

**WHEREAS,** Dr. Robinson is also known to make house visits to patients when they could not come to the clinic, or to take calls and provide instant service even in the late evening or the wee hours of the morning, with no complaints, no qualms, and sometimes, no pay; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Robinson, and his wife Tina, have helped several homeless people, not only providing free medical treatment to this vulnerable population, but from time to time, they also welcomed them into their home and housed them for brief periods of time; and

**WHEREAS,** Dr. Robinson did not only care for the poor and the homeless, but he also provided free medical treatment to people with disabilities, and to those that are suffering not only from their disabling condition, but from the pain of being unable to care for themselves and unable to obtain care from others; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Robinson did not only spend quality time with the poor, the needy, and the vulnerable, but he fulfilled his role as a professional whose depth of knowledge and vast experience in helping the people of Guam afflicted with chronic diseases made him an invaluable lecturer and a contributing officer of the Guam Medical Association, the Guam Diabetes Association, the Guam SPIMA Organization, and the Guam Sustantia Coalition; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Robinson was the Project Director and Principal Investigator of the Guam Sustantia Project, which had a quarter of a million dollar grant funded by the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation (RWJF) to address the childhood obesity epidemic on the island of Guam; and

WHEREAS, through the guidance and direction of Dr. Robinson, the Sustantia Project successfully promoted healthy eating habits and active living among the children of Guam; and also helped to rehabilitate playgrounds in Guam's villages to encourage an active lifestyle among children; and

WHEREAS, the success of the Sustantia Project put Guam on the map, through the selection for the presentation of this project at national and international conferences by the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, such as *Healthy Kids, Healthy Nation*, held at the CNN Center in Atlanta, Georgia in October 2009; the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Centers for Disease Control and Prevention National Conference on Health Communication, Marketing, and Media, held at the CNN Center in Atlanta, Georgia in August 2010; and the European Childhood Obesity Group 20<sup>th</sup> ECOG Congress, held at the European Parliament in Brussels, Belgium in November 2010; and
