3 **WHEREAS,** Guam Marshal Captain Joey A. Terlaje was born on March 31,
4 1973. He is the son of Mayor Jose “Pedo” Terlaje and Mrs. Flo Terlaje; and his

1 **WHEREAS**, Captain Joey Terlaje celebrates his service and accomplishments
2 with Melissa, his wife of eighteen (18) years; and his children, Joey Jr., Joneen,
3 Jonessa, Janavon, Jodeci Jon Luke; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Captain Joey Terlaje is a Criminal Justice Major with over
5 twenty-three (23) years of experience in law enforcement, and he currently serves as a
6 Captain with the Judiciary of Guam Marshals Division. He is a professionally active
7 and well-rounded individual with numerous tactical trainings, to include: Active
8 Shooter Instructor (Anderson Air Force Base, Guam); Laser Shot Firearms Simulator
9 (*Mangilao*, Guam); Blackwater Special Weapons and Tactics (S.W.A.T) Instructor
10 (Moyok, North Carolina); Defensive Tactics Instructor (PPCT); Impact Weapon or
11 MEB (PPCT); Tactical Handcuffing (PPCT); Inmate Escort (PPCT); Pepper Spray
12 (OCAT); Incident Response to a Terrorist Bombing (Socorro, New Mexico);
13 Prevention Response to a Suicide Bombing Incident (Deming, New Mexico);
14 Introduction to Weapons of Mass Destruction (Las Vegas, Nevada); Tactical Tracker
15 (Mesquite, Nevada); Firearms Instructor (Sig Saur Academy); Folding Knife
16 Instructor (*Hagåtña*, Guam); Low Light Principles for Law Enforcement Instructor
17 (PPCT); and Spontaneous Knife Defense Instructor (PPCT); and

18 **WHEREAS**, Captain Joey Terlaje is a former Guam Airport Police Officer; he
19 is a graduate of the Guam Police Academy, Guam Police Department 1st S.W.A.T
20 Cycle, in 1994; and he attended the Blackwater S.W.A.T Instructor Academy at the
21 main facility in Moyok, North Carolina, in 2000, all of which are not easily attained;
22 and

23 **WHEREAS**, Captain Joey Terlaje has received advance trainings, to include:
24 the United States Marine Corps Combat Handgun Course; the Drug Enforcement
25 Administration (DEA) Close Quarters Battle; the Federal Bureau of Investigations
26 (FBI) Police Officers Survival School; Guam Homeland Security; the U.S. Customs

1 Officers Survival Course; U.S. Marshals Service; the Navy SEALs, Close-Quarter-
2 Battle (CQB); and he attended the National Tactical Officers Association (NTOA)
3 SWAT Commanders Course in Las Vegas, Nevada; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Captain Joey Terlaje is the founder of the Special Enforcement
5 and Tactics Team for the Guam Marshals Division; and he is highly recognized as a
6 Master Tactician by his peers, and holds a brown belt in the Universal Kempo Karate
7 Schools Association; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Captain Joey Terlaje was awarded as the 2014 Employee
9 Recognition Program (ERP) “Supervisor of the Year.” He is a 2009 Medal of Valor
10 winner; and he was nominated for the 2009 “Employee of the Year” award, and was
11 awarded second (2nd) place by the Justice Committee; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Captain Joey Terlaje received the Justice F. Philip Carbullido
13 Coin for outstanding service, and he received numerous awards and recognition from
14 the Guam Community College (GCC), the Governor of Guam (*I Maga'laha*
15 *Guåhan*), the Guam Legislature (*I Liheslaturan Guåhan*), the Guam Police
16 Department (GPD), and the Department of Education (DOE); and

17 **WHEREAS**, Captain Joey Terlaje is currently the Officer-in-Charge for the
18 training section of the Judiciary of Guam Marshals Division; and since 2005, he has
19 been teaching quality, informative, realistic, recent and relevant courses in Guam, the
20 Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands and the Micronesian region, to
21 include, Palau, Chuuk, Yap, Pohnpei, Kosrae and Majuro; and

22 **WHEREAS**, Captain Joey Terlaje was the Senior Cadre/Adjunct Instructor for
23 the 10th, 11th and 12th; and is now concluding the 13th Criminal Justice Supplemental
24 Academy at the Guam Community College as Senior Cadre, which started on June 1,
25 2015 and will conclude on August 15, 2015. He has taught hundreds of students in
26 the private sector, as well as law enforcement officers, S.W.A.T teams, Guam

1 Marshals, Guam Police Officers, Parole Officers, Corrections Officers, Airport Police
2 Officers, Customs Officers, Department of Youth Affairs Officers, Truant Officers,
3 and Security Officers; and

5 confident in his instructional methodologies that instill the virtues of organization,
