- 3 WHEREAS, Guam is considered as an underserved area by the U.S.
- 4 Department of Health and Human Services. Guam has a great need for certain

1 medical services, not only specialty and primary care physicians, but also medical specialty clinics; and

WHEREAS, Guam and the neighboring islands are known to have some of the highest rates of diabetes, especially among the *Chamorro* population, and there is a very high prevalence of diabetic kidney disease causing end stage renal disease (ESRD). The prevalence of ESRD is two and a half to three times higher than that of the U.S. mainland; and

WHEREAS, for this reason, the need for dialysis clinics, which are highly specialized and highly sanitized to meet the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services standards, is great in order to deliver high quality care to the diabetic patients of Guam and the neighboring islands; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Saied Safabakhsh, MD, FACP, FASN, who has served the people of Guam and the neighboring islands for many years providing comfort and ease to those who have sought his medical expertise, decided to dedicate his resources to build an edifice of superior medical care for the people of Guam and the region; and named the complex, "The Village," which recognizes the concept of a comprehensive center servicing the needs of its patients; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the grand opening of this state of the art dialysis center, included was a medical complex that would offer kidney specialty clinics, eye clinics, and related services, for patients that undergo dialysis treatments. This modality would allow the patient to have a more comfortable, convenient time, and have easier access to care; and

WHEREAS, the start of this venture had a significant pressing issue to overcome, and that was to locate land on Guam that is more in the central and south, so that access to the dialysis center is easier for the patients of southern Guam. As

1 there was no proper medical complex in the central and southern areas that can

2 support dialysis care, the location factor was of prime importance; and

WHEREAS, "The Village" idea started to become a reality after the late Honorable Vicente "Ben" C. Pangelinan took it upon himself to help change the zoning of the property to a commercial zone for the purpose of establishing a medical facility; and

WHEREAS, "The Village" consists of a huge medical storage facility, kidney specialty clinics, an internal medicine clinic (Pacific Medical Group), an ophthalmology clinic, a clinical psychology clinic, a drive-thru pharmacy, and laboratory and radiology services; and

WHEREAS, the medical storage facility is meant to have six (6) months worth of medical supplies in the event of typhoons and natural disasters; and this state of the art facility is designed and furnished towards patient comfort and experience; and

WHEREAS, the outpatient dialysis clinic, which is the largest clinic of its kind on the island, is positioned to serve the south and central patients. The clinic is often called the patient's second home due to the time a procedure takes. With this in mind, the interior design depicts a spa-like ambiance evoking a positive level of response from patients physically, intellectually and emotionally. The exterior facade depicts a modern Mediterranean style motif with an old world charm. The Bali sand stones, landscape and waterfall design exudes a sense of peace and tranquility, not to mention enhancing the visual beauty and environment of the village of *Sinajana*; and

WHEREAS, "The Village" will serve a much needed purpose and assuredly will provide excellent health care for the people of Guam and the region; now therefore, be it
