3 WHEREAS, Greg Borja is a *Chamorro* native who was born and raised on 4 Guam, and he has strong southern roots in *Malesso* and *Sumay*. He enlisted in the 5 U.S. Navy in 1984, and he served until 1997; and WHEREAS, Greg attended basic training at RTC Great Lakes, Illinois, and he served as an Operations Specialist. He was stationed on the USS Cook FF-1083 at San Diego, California; the USS Niagara Falls AFS-3 at Naval Station, Guam; and the USS Ingersoll DD-990 at Pearl Harbor, Hawaii. He is a Gulf War Veteran, and he has been on six (6) Western Pacific deployments; and he had served during Operation Desert Storm in 1991; and

WHEREAS, in 2008, Greg started working at the former Veterans Affairs
(VA) Clinic at the Guam Naval Hospital. The following year, he became a Social
Worker and Case Manager and was assigned to the VA Healthcare Clinic; and he
served as a Social Worker for the VA Homeless program; and

WHEREAS, in 2012, Greg was reassigned to serve at the VA Benefits Office
as the Fiduciary and Veterans Service Officer of the Department of Veterans Affairs,
Guam; and

WHEREAS, during his six (6) years of service to our island Veterans, Mr.
Borja has assisted over one thousand (1000) Veterans and their families with benefits,
to include compensation and pension, aid and attendance for our homebound Veterans
to receive the utmost quality of homecare; and he helped to transition more than ten
(10) homeless Veterans into homes with assisted living services and healthcare; and

WHEREAS, in 2013, Greg became the Vice President of the Iraq Afghanistan and Persian Gulf Veterans of the Pacific (IAPGVP), a regional Veteran's service organization on Guam. He has guided the organization to recognize Veterans on Guam for their service, and to provide programs that assisted in the homecoming of our service members; and

VA National Competitions, such as at the VA National Golden Age Games and at the
VA National Creative Art Competition in 2012 and 2013. He has also organized the
youngest generation of Veterans to compete at the upcoming National Summer Games
in 2016; and

9 WHEREAS, Greg is very popular amongst the Veterans, and he is known to be an intelligent, hardworking, and humble individual with excellent leadership skills. 10 He has been an advocate for Guam Veterans who have been faced with many 11 12 obstacles in accessing healthcare services. He has gone above and beyond his call to 13 duty to ensure that such healthcare services were being rendered by the Pacific Island Healthcare System in Honolulu, Hawaii. He has maintained a positive and friendly 14 attitude with the Veterans and their families. The Veterans are very grateful to have 15 16 such a respectful and dedicated person in their community, and would like to thank him for his service and wish him well in his future endeavors; now therefore, be it 17
