9 valued and under-utilized resource in our community that is needed, and they are a  
10 barometer of change and justice for the future; and

11           **WHEREAS**, the youth are becoming more active in volunteering activities,  
12 seeing it as more than just a civic responsibility, but also an important step to creating  
13 change and an opportunity to solving problems in our community; and the youth are  
14 continuously seeking new ways of volunteering by utilizing the internet and many  
15 other tools to generate global impacts in our society; and

16           **WHEREAS**, volunteering has tremendous benefits to the youth, including  
17 becoming more engaged and empowered to participate in community life, building a  
18 sense of ownership and a sense of community, taking on active leadership roles,
