3 **WHEREAS,** the Guam Young Professionals was formed in January of 2010 as
4 a committee of the Guam Chamber of Commerce; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the Guam Young Professionals is an initiative of the Guam
2 Chamber of Commerce that recognizes the economic and social importance of
3 engaging our young professionals in all issues and opportunities impacting our
4 community and region to lead our island into the future; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the Guam Young Professionals is organized under the umbrella of
6 the Guam Chamber of Commerce, and currently operates in a committee structure
7 under the direction of a steering committee. This steering committee determines the
8 board make-up of the organization, its bylaws and its operational agenda; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the Guam Young Professionals serves as the voice for young
10 professionals in all forums; and networks and fosters relationships with its members,
11 employers, and other special interest groups to promote increased participation; it also
12 enables its members to meet and interact with prominent business and philanthropic
13 leaders, and to gain leadership experience through committee and board involvement;
14 and

15 **WHEREAS**, Régine Biscoe Lee is the daughter of Mrs. Rosita and Captain
16 Michael Mahony (USN, Ret.) and Roland Biscoe; and resides on Guam with her
17 husband, Andy; and their two (2) daughters, Mia and Nina; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Régine Biscoe Lee is a 1999 graduate of the Academy of Our
19 Lady of Guam, and a 2003 graduate of the University of Washington; and

20 **WHEREAS**, before returning to Guam, Régine Biscoe Lee was a Senior
21 Associate at NVG, LLC., a political consulting firm in Washington, D.C.; she served
22 as a founding board member for KAYA-DC; and she was a member of the Asian
23 American Action Fund-Young Professionals. After returning to Guam, she served on
24 the board of the Guam Women’s Club and Soroptimist International of Guam; and

25 **WHEREAS**, Régine Biscoe Lee brings a wealth of experience and expertise in
26 public relations, event management, community outreach, and strategic

1 communications to service her clients as the Public Relations and Account Service
2 Manager at Ruder Integrated Marketing Strategies (RIMS). She previously served as
3 a Policy Advisor for Congresswoman Madeleine Z. Bordallo (D-GU), as Chief of
4 Staff for Senator Tina Muña Barnes, and as a Senior Consultant with Booz Allen
5 Hamilton-Guam; and

6 **WHEREAS**, in 2009, Régine Biscoe Lee was named as one of the “100 Most
7 Influential Women in the U.S.”; and she was also recognized as a “Builder and
8 Emerging Leader” by the Filipina Women’s Network for her work on behalf of
9 Veterans and various other communities in need; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Régine Biscoe Lee currently serves as the Vice-Chairperson with
11 Sanctuary, Inc., of Guam; as Secretary of Breaking the Cycle Guam; she is a member
12 of the Guam Women’s Club; and she is also a volunteer for the Salvation Army,
13 Rainbows for All Children, and *Payu-ta*, Inc.; and

14 **WHEREAS**, in 2011, Régine Biscoe Lee received a FLAG Sampaguita Award;
15 she was elected as a Delegate from Guam to the 2012 Democratic National
16 Convention; and in January 2015, she was named as the Guam Chamber of
17 Commerce’s “2014 Reina A. Leddy Young Professional of the Year”; now therefore,
18 be it
