3           **WHEREAS,** Edna Pesarillo Antonio was born on September 12, 1955, in  
4 Pandacan, Manila, Philippines. She is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. †Clemente Q. and  
5 Lolita P. Antonio; and her siblings are Billie, Angelica and Wilfredo; and

1           **WHEREAS**, Edna Pesarillo Antonio attended Saint Joseph Elementary School  
2 in Pandacan, Manila, and graduated in April of 1968; and later that year, she visited  
3 Guam for the first time at the age of thirteen (13). For her high school education,  
4 Edna attended Saint Joseph Girls High School in Pandacan, Manila, and graduated in  
5 April of 1972; and

6           **WHEREAS**, after graduating from high school, Edna Pesarillo Antonio studied  
7 Pre-Nursing at the Far Eastern University (FEU) in Manila, from 1972 to 1974; and  
8 from 1974 to 1977, she then went on to further her education for her internship and  
9 nursing at the Quezon City Medical Center School of Nursing in Quezon City,  
10 Philippines; and

11           **WHEREAS**, after graduating as a registered nurse in 1977, Edna began her  
12 nursing career and worked at the Jeddah Medical Center in Saudi Arabia, where she  
13 served from 1978 to 1984. On June 23, 1984, she welcomed her only daughter, Maria  
14 Everette Antonio, into this world; and

15           **WHEREAS**, in August of 1985, Edna relocated to Guam with her daughter,  
16 Maria Everette. From October 1985 to 1987, she worked in the Guam Memorial  
17 Hospital Authority (GMHA) Skilled Nursing Unit (SNU) as a Certified Nursing  
18 Assistant (CNA). Later in 1987, she transferred to the Guam Memorial Hospital  
19 Authority (GMHA) Medical-Surgical Ward, where she continued to serve as a  
20 Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA); and she had also worked as a home care nurse on  
21 a part-time basis from 1987 to 2008; and

22           **WHEREAS**, Edna had also worked as a Sales Clerk at the Yokohama Okadaya  
23 Duty Free Store at the Tropicana Hotel in *Tumon*, from 1992 to 1998. When Edna is  
24 not working, she enjoys cooking, collecting crystal figures, watching soap operas  
25 (telesyre) and singing; and

26           **WHEREAS**, Edna Pesarillo Antonio had received numerous awards while  
27 serving at the Medical-Surgical Ward unit of the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority

1 (GMHA), including: “Most Dependable”; “Nurse Aide of the Year”; “Outstanding  
2 Commitment and Dedication to Patient Care”; “Best Dressed”; “Outstanding Service  
3 Bravo Award”; “Most Efficient and Dedicated Award”; and “Best in Bedside Care”;  
4 and she was also a nominee for the Governor’s Award of Excellence; now therefore,


14 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules


