1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I MINA'TRENTAI***  
2 ***TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN:***

3           **WHEREAS, drug and alcohol abuse has devastating consequences on the community**  
4 **at large, most especially on families and youth who have endured firsthand the harmful**

1 effects of this widespread epidemic. As an island community, we value the health and safety  
2 of our residents, especially Guam’s youth. Today, we face many challenges as we try to  
3 protect our loved ones from the ongoing battle against substance abuse; and

4 **WHEREAS**, substance abuse either through the use of drugs or alcohol, not only has  
5 a negative effect on individuals, families, businesses and schools, but it is also a contributing  
6 factor in the three (3) leading causes of death among adolescents, which are accidents,  
7 homicides, and suicides; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the “Red Ribbon Campaign” began in 1985 after drug traffickers in  
9 Mexico City murdered Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) agent Enrique “Kiki”  
10 Camarena. His friends and neighbors wore red badges of satin signifying their utmost  
11 respect and admiration for his courage, determination, and his honorable and ultimate  
12 sacrifice; and to show that they would continue to take up his fight against illegal drug  
13 activities. The mission of the “Red Ribbon Campaign” is to present a unified and visible  
14 commitment towards the creation of a “Drug-Free America”; and

15 **WHEREAS**, recognizing the seriousness of this threat, the National Family  
16 Partnership initiated the first “Red Ribbon Campaign” in 1986. This grassroots effort  
17 emphasized education and the importance of teaching children, teenagers, families, and  
18 communities in every corner of the country about the dangers of substance abuse; and since  
19 then, significant progress has been made in reducing drug and alcohol abuse among young  
20 adults; and

21 **WHEREAS**, Guam’s participation in this national effort was started in 1988 by the  
22 *Dededo* Drug-Free Organization (now known as Youth for Youth LIVE! Guam). The 2015  
23 “Red Ribbon Campaign” Committee is comprised of representatives from federal and local  
24 government agencies; the military; non-profit organizations; and the Guam Chamber of  
25 Commerce; and

26 **WHEREAS**, the 2015 “Red Ribbon Campaign” theme is: “Respect Yourself. Be  
27 Drug Free!” and some of this year’s activities include: an essay contest; a school gate/wall  
28 decorating contest; a Red Ribbon Wave in *Hagåtña*; a community outreach at the Micronesia

1 Mall; a “Say Boo to Drugs” community event; school presentations; and numerous print,  
2 television, and radio media events; and

3 **WHEREAS**, education, prevention, and outreach activities are critical weapons in the  
4 community’s effort to fight substance abuse. It is the goal of the “Red Ribbon Campaign”  
5 Committee to involve families, schools, businesses, churches, law enforcement agencies and  
6 service organizations to establish an atmosphere that supports awareness and education that  
7 will help to prevent substance abuse related activities; and

8 **WHEREAS**, on the occasion of the 2015 “Red Ribbon Month,” *I Mina'Trentai Tres*  
9 *Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* encourages all the residents of Guam to consider ways to  
10 participate in this important effort. As we build upon the successes of the past, we  
11 strengthen the Guam of tomorrow; and with strong resolve and creative leadership, we must  
12 strive to protect our community from the preventable dangers of alcohol, tobacco, and drug  
13 abuse; and


14 **WHEREAS**, these “Red Ribbon Campaign” activities are being made possible by the  
15 “Red Ribbon Campaign” Committee; and the ongoing awareness efforts will concentrate on  
16 promoting healthy choices and lifestyles that are drug, alcohol, tobacco, and violence-free;  
17 now therefore, be it

18 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na Liheslaturan*  
19 *Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam, recognize

27 “National Red Ribbon Week,” from October 23 to October 31, 2015, in recognition of our  
28 commitment to being a safe, healthy, and drug-free community; and be it further

1           **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules  
2 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the  
3 same be thereafter transmitted to the “Red Ribbon Campaign” Committee; and to the  
4 Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga’láhen Guáhan*.
