1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** Calvo's Insurance was founded seventy-seven (77) years ago in
4 1938 by Eduardo T. "Jake" Calvo; and the SelectCare portion of the company was
5 started in September 2000, and has grown greatly in the past fifteen (15) years; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Paul Calvo, Jr., Executive Vice President and General Manager of
2 Calvo’s Insurance; Kenyu Okuda, Chief Operating Officer of Tokio Marine Pacific
3 Insurance Limited; Frank Campillo, Health Plan Administrator, and many others, lead
4 the organization in providing medical insurance coverage to over thirty-eight thousand
5 (38,000) members; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the SelectCare medical plan allows access to more than one
7 hundred (100) physicians and clinics in the region, as well as to more than three
8 hundred fifty thousand (350,000) health care providers in the United States and the
9 Philippines; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the SelectCare Plan was originally insured by Nichido Insurance;
11 and then in 2004, it merged with Tokio Marine and formed a local Guam company,
12 Tokio Marine Pacific Insurance (TMPI), becoming a subsidiary of Tokio Marine
13 Holdings, a global insurance conglomerate; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Tokio Marine Pacific Insurance is the only AM Best rated health
15 insurer on Guam, is rated A+, and employs twenty (20) Guam residents; and

16 **WHEREAS**, SelectCare introduced the first web-based application for its
17 members’ use; and

18 **WHEREAS**, SelectCare insures the Government of Guam employees and
19 retirees, the Federal employees and annuitants, and various commercial groups in
20 Guam, the CNMI and Palau; and

21 **WHEREAS**, SelectCare opened an office in Koror, Palau, in 2006; and it
22 opened a service office in Manila in 2007; and

23 **WHEREAS**, SelectCare became the sole provider of health insurance benefits
24 for the Government of Guam in 2008 due to the departure of other carriers from this
25 market; and

1 **WHEREAS**, SelectCare was approved to offer health insurance benefits to the
2 Federal employees and annuitants starting with the 2013 calendar year; and

3 **WHEREAS**, SelectCare has introduced unique health insurance offerings to
4 the market, such as the high deductible health plan that allows Health Savings
5 Accounts, and the Philippine only plan, along with introducing wellness programs
6 with partnerships that include the SDA Clinic, Paradise Fitness, and Synergy in 2009;
7 and

8 **WHEREAS**, SelectCare continues its efforts in preventing illness by
9 introducing the free gym benefit for GovGuam employees, deep discounted gym
10 memberships for commercial groups, and comprehensive wellness programs that
11 include smoking cessation, diabetes management, and access to gym partners; and

12 **WHEREAS**, SelectCare offers a life saving Air Ambulance discount program
13 to all insured members; and it continues to provide a high-level of service to the
14 people of Guam with a wealth of programs, including wellness and health initiatives,
15 and its Air Ambulance program has already saved ten (10) lives; and

16 **WHEREAS**, since its establishment, Selectcare has been a community partner
17 and collaborator on many health initiatives, including its participation in the
18 Governor's Worksite Wellness Program, the Non-Communicable Disease
19 Consortium, and numerous other activities of local, community-based organizations it
20 has supported; and

21 **WHEREAS**, SelectCare is very generous in its nature, and has given donations
22 to many local organizations, including the Guam Memorial Hospital Volunteers
23 Association, which in turn has used these donations to purchase critically-needed
24 hospital equipment for the Guam Memorial Hospital; now therefore, be it

25 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*
26 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people


1 of Guam, commend and congratulate Calvo's SelectCare on the occasion of its
2 Fifteenth (15th) Year Anniversary; and does further extend a warm *Un Dangkolo Na Si*
3 *Yu'os Ma'åse'* to Calvo's SelectCare for its contributions, and for its dedication and
4 service to the healthcare needs of the people of Guam and the Pacific region; and be it
5 further

6 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
7 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of
