1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, on October 10, 2015, the people of Taiwan will celebrate the One
4 Hundred Fourth (104th) “Double-Tenth National Day” of the establishment of the
5 Republic of China (Taiwan), a day that commemorates the triumph over the Ching
6 Dynasty, and the beginning of the Republic of China under the leadership of Dr. Sun
7 Yat-Sen; and

1 **WHEREAS**, since 1973, the people of Guam have shared a special Sister-City
2 bond with the people of Taipei City that has benefited Guam and Taiwan through
3 cultural exchanges and economic investments; and

4 **WHEREAS**, this strong Sister-City relationship, that has lasted for more than
5 four (4) decades, has translated into millions of dollars in investments on Guam,
6 which the people of Guam are grateful for; and

7 **WHEREAS**, following Japan and Korea with the third largest numbers of
8 tourists traveling to Guam, around fifty thousand (50,000) visitors from Taiwan have
9 come to visit Guam last fiscal year, fostering the growth of tourism, which is one of
10 Guam's primary industries; and

11 **WHEREAS**, prior to 2009, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* has adopted legislative
12 resolutions commending the efforts of Taiwan to promote World Health, and the
13 endorsement of Taiwan to observer status in the World Health Assembly, the supreme
14 governing body of the United Nations World Health Organization; as well as to
15 support the inclusion of the Republic of China (Taiwan) in the United Nations
16 Specialized Agencies, such as the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO)
17 and the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change; and

18 **WHEREAS**, on April 29, 2009, Taiwan was invited to take part as an observer
19 in the World Health Assembly; and in September 2013, Taiwan's delegation had been
20 invited as guests of the president of the ICAO Council, Robert Gonzalez, to attend the
21 38th assembly of the ICAO in Montreal, two (2) major breakthroughs for Taiwan's
22 persistent campaign for more active participation in international activities; and

23 **WHEREAS**, the Taiwanese and Chinese Community of Guam, including the
24 Taiwanese Business Association of Guam, the United Chinese Association of Guam,
25 the Chinese Chamber of Commerce of Guam, and the Chinese Ladies Association of
26 Guam, continue to be at the forefront of various worthwhile community projects
27 throughout Guam; and the people of Guam are grateful for the generosity the
28 Taiwanese and Chinese Community of Guam has extended to the community; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the people of Guam, both from the government and the private
2 sectors, recognize the continued humanitarian efforts, determination, commitments
3 and labor that the various Taiwanese and Chinese organizations contribute to Guam
4 and its residents; now therefore, be it

5 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*
6 *LiheSlaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I LiheSlaturan Guåhan* and the people
7 of Guam, congratulate the Republic of China (Taiwan) on the occasion of the One
8 Hundred Fourth (104th) “Double-Tenth National Day”; and recognize and commend
9 the Taiwanese and Chinese Community of Guam for its many invaluable
10 contributions to Guam; and does further extend *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to
11 the Taiwanese and Chinese Community of Guam for its efforts in fostering a closer
12 relationship with the people of Guam; and be it further

13 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
14 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of
15 the same be thereafter transmitted to the Honorable Ken C.P. Hu, Director General of
