- 5 Republic of China (Taiwan), a day that commemorates the triumph over the Ching
- 6 Dynasty, and the beginning of the Republic of China under the leadership of Dr. Sun
- 7 Yat-Sen; and

WHEREAS, since 1973, the people of Guam have shared a special Sister-City bond with the people of Taipei City that has benefited Guam and Taiwan through cultural exchanges and economic investments; and

**WHEREAS,** this strong Sister-City relationship, that has lasted for more than four (4) decades, has translated into millions of dollars in investments on Guam, which the people of Guam are grateful for; and

WHEREAS, following Japan and Korea with the third largest numbers of tourists traveling to Guam, around fifty thousand (50,000) visitors from Taiwan have come to visit Guam last fiscal year, fostering the growth of tourism, which is one of Guam's primary industries; and

WHEREAS, prior to 2009, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* has adopted legislative resolutions commending the efforts of Taiwan to promote World Health, and the endorsement of Taiwan to observer status in the World Health Assembly, the supreme governing body of the United Nations World Health Organization; as well as to support the inclusion of the Republic of China (Taiwan) in the United Nations Specialized Agencies, such as the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) and the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change; and

WHEREAS, on April 29, 2009, Taiwan was invited to take part as an observer in the World Health Assembly; and in September 2013, Taiwan's delegation had been invited as guests of the president of the ICAO Council, Robert Gonzalez, to attend the 38<sup>th</sup> assembly of the ICAO in Montreal, two (2) major breakthroughs for Taiwan's persistent campaign for more active participation in international activities; and

WHEREAS, the Taiwanese and Chinese Community of Guam, including the Taiwanese Business Association of Guam, the United Chinese Association of Guam, the Chinese Chamber of Commerce of Guam, and the Chinese Ladies Association of Guam, continue to be at the forefront of various worthwhile community projects throughout Guam; and the people of Guam are grateful for the generosity the Taiwanese and Chinese Community of Guam has extended to the community; and

WHEREAS, the people of Guam, both from the government and the private sectors, recognize the continued humanitarian efforts, determination, commitments and labor that the various Taiwanese and Chinese organizations contribute to Guam and its residents; now therefore, be it
