3        **WHEREAS,** Vickie Fish was born and raised in Milton, Wisconsin; and she is the  
4        daughter of the late Dr. Hal R. Deal and Mrs. Martha Jane Bowen Deal. She is the  
5        wife of Mark O. Fish, and they have been married for forty-one (41) years; and is also

1 the proud mother of Brett Mabson Keolahouonalani Fish and Jacquelyn Kanoekalani  
2 Fish; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Vickie graduated from the Carthage College in Kenosha, Wisconsin,  
4 with a Bachelors of Arts in Art Education; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Vickie began her career journey in 1974, serving as a teacher and  
6 trainer for the Peace Corps Volunteers in the Kingdom of Tonga; and in 1979, she  
7 served as a program coordinator and trainer for the economic development and federal  
8 aging program services for Micronesia, while working for the Trust Territory of the  
9 Pacific Islands headquarters in Saipan; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Vickie has faithfully served the community as a member of the Board  
11 of Directors of the Sugar Plum Tree for twenty-seven (27) years; as a Sunday School  
12 teacher at the Lutheran Church of Guam for the past thirteen (13) years; and as a room  
13 mother, a parent volunteer and a PTA officer at Saint John's School for the past  
14 seventeen (17) years; and

15 **WHEREAS**, in 1983, Vickie moved to Guam and made it her home; and in 1996,  
16 she began her nineteen (19) year career with the Guam Girl Scouts, Inc., serving as the  
17 Executive Director; and had also served as a Volunteer Troop Leader for three (3)  
18 years; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Vickie developed positive relationships among the Guam Girl Scouts  
20 and the Girl Scouts of the USA national staff, as well as with various local businesses,  
21 the government, organizations, agencies, and individuals; and

22 **WHEREAS**, Vickie established a wide base of individual and corporate financial  
23 support within the community, and she achieved clean annual audits to ensure  
24 compliance with all government reporting requirements; and

25 **WHEREAS**, Vickie worked to increase awareness of the Guam Girl Scouts  
26 program and what it offers to girls from all backgrounds. Vickie, along with the staff

1 team, grew its membership to nearly one thousand (1,000) members; and began a  
2 balanced membership ratio to reflect our island's multi-cultural population; and


3 **WHEREAS**, Vickie expanded various skill-building, service, and leadership  
4 development programs connecting girls with environmental, career, educational,  
5 family, and civic needs; now therefore, be it
