1           **WHEREAS**, Marlon D.C. Leano is married to Eleanor Umayam Leano; and  
2 they are blessed with two (2) daughters, Marlene Leano of Covington, Washington,  
3 and Julie Ann Leano of Kapolei, Hawaii; and

4           **WHEREAS**, in 1979, Marlon D.C. Leano obtained a Bachelor of Science  
5 Degree in Civil Engineering from FEATI University in Manila, Philippines; and

6           **WHEREAS**, Marlon D.C. Leano began his career as a Draftsman with CE  
7 Services, Inc., from 1983 to 1984; and he then worked as a Project Engineer with  
8 Pacific Drilling Inc./Delta Construction, from 1984 to 1985; and

9           **WHEREAS**, during his tenure with the Department of Public Works, Marlon  
10 served in various positions, beginning as an Engineer II with the Construction Quality  
11 Control Section, from 1986 to 2005; he was appointed as the Acting Chief of  
12 Engineering for the Highway Division in 1999; and his final position was as an  
13 Engineer III of the Highway Maintenance and Construction Section, from 2005 to  
14 January 2, 2015, when he retired with thirty-two (32) years of service; and

15           **WHEREAS**, Marlon achieved recognition as the “DPW Supervisor of the  
16 Year” in 1996; and also, as a Project Engineer he was instrumental in the Highway  
17 Maintenance and Construction Section of DPW receiving the 2013 Governor’s

19 the Gill-Baza Subdivision; and he was the Coordinator for DPW’s “Get Up and

4 of Guam; and be it further


5 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to,
