4           **WHEREAS**, in January 1990, William joined the Department of Youth Affairs  
5 (DYA) and was employed as a Youth Service Worker II; and

6           **WHEREAS**, throughout his years of service with DYA, William was assigned  
7 additional duties, including: Community Social Casework (2005-2007),  
8 JumpStart/Aftercare Program (September 2005-May 2015), DYA School Children  
9 Outreach Empowerment Program (October 2011), DYA CHANSA (CHANCE)  
10 (October 2011), Public Information Officer (April 2010-May 2015), and Internal  
11 Investigations Officer (2010-2015); and

12           **WHEREAS**, on several occasions, William served as the DYA Youth  
13 Corrections Superintendent (31 May - 29 June 2014; 19 September - 18 October 2014;  
14 5 February - 21 April 2015); and

15           **WHEREAS**, prior to working with DYA, William spent many years in the  
16 field of engineering and electrical service, to include: 58<sup>th</sup> Engineering Company, Fort  
17 Dixon, New Jersey (1980-1984); AHN Electrical Services (1985-1987); 297<sup>th</sup>  
18 Engineer, Army Reserve Center (1986); DEWITT Transport from (1987-1988);  
19 PanPacific Builders (1988-1990); and Operation Iraqi Freedom 18-month deployment  
20 (2004-2005); and

21           **WHEREAS**, William has pursued special training in areas to benefit his career  
22 and service to the people of Guam, to include: CEOS 0508 Wheeled Vehicle  
23 Mechanic, Central Texas College (1982); Primary Leadership Development Course,  
24 4960<sup>th</sup> U.S. Army Reserve Forces School, Fort Derussy, Hawaii (1992); Youth  
25 Correctional Officer Training, Guam Community College (1993); Employee  
26 Grievance and Adverse Action Procedures, Panel member of Grievance Committee

1 Department of Administration (2013) and; Incident Response to Terrorist Bombings  
2 Awareness Training Course, New Mexico Tech (2014); Mastering Peak Performance,  
3 and Peace Officer Standards Training; and

4 **WHEREAS**, throughout his career, William received a number of certificates  
5 and awards: Certificate of Promotion, U.S. Army-Specialist Four (1982); Good  
6 Conduct Medal (1<sup>st</sup> award), Department of the Army (1980-1983); as well as various

9 Chamorro Language Liaison, *Silibrasion Mes Chamorro* (2014); and


10 **WHEREAS**, alongside his training and service, William dedicated his time to

15 Center in *Agat*; now therefore, be it


16 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*
