1       **WHEREAS**, one of the missions of the Aklan Association of Guam is to  
2 establish a single and unified association of Aklanons residing on Guam, which  
3 embodies its ideals of unity, civic spirit and brotherhood, and preserves the worthy  
4 and cherished cultures and traditions of the province of Aklan; to render assistance to  
5 the people of both the mother country, the Philippines, and the country of adoption;  
6 and to promote the individual and collective welfare of each member; and

7       **WHEREAS**, the Aklan Association of Guam was also formed for the purposes  
8 of uniting and promoting closer relations and camaraderie among fellow Aklanons; to  
9 render aid and to assist fellow members to cooperate with the authorities of Guam in  
10 the maintenance of peace and order among Filipinos; to assist the Philippine  
11 Consulate General in its civic, cultural and social activities; and to provide

14 organization through various charitable and civic endeavors, to include the  
15 construction and completion of a picnic shelter at the Governor Joseph Flores (*Ypao*)  
16 Beach Park; the donation of six (6) wheelchairs and blood pressure apparatus to the  
17 Kalibo Provincial Hospital in Kalibo, Aklan, Philippines; financial assistance for  
18 disaster relief for the victims of flooding and typhoon, in 2006; assistance to the  
19 Filipino Community of Guam during fundraising efforts; and the underwriting of  
20 tuition fees for four (4) scholars enrolled at the Aklan College through graduation; and

21       **WHEREAS**, the Aklan Association of Guam continues to play an active role in  
22 brotherhood and unity by participating in the annual Guam Liberation Day Parade;  
23 and the American Cancer Society Cancer Survivors Walk and Airplane Pull; and

25 role in the community through its participation in other civic, educational and cultural  
26 organizations, such as the Guam Lions Clubs and the Guam Memorial Hospital

1       **WHEREAS**, the Aklan Association of Guam is an active member of the Filipino  
2 Community of Guam, and is a founding member of the *Santo Niño* Guam in 2000,  
3 which annually celebrates the feast of the *Santo Niño* every second Sunday of  
4 January; now therefore, be it

6 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
