1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, the late Luis Leon Guerrero Paulino was born on September 23,
4 1938, and is the son of †Leocadio Cepeda Paulino and †Maria Leon Guerrero Paulino
5 and Bartola Salas Paulino; he was called to his eternal reward on Friday, September
6 25, 2015, at the age of seventy seven (77); and

7 **WHEREAS**, on August 13, 1960, the late Luis Leon Guerrero Paulino married
8 †Victoria Meno Chargualaf at Saint Joseph's Church in *Inarajan*, and they were

1 blessed with four (4) sons: Luis Jr., Paul, Anthony, and Glenn; sixteen (16)
2 grandchildren; and ten (10) great grandchildren; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the late Luis Leon Guerrero Paulino graduated from George
4 Washington High School in 1957 and a few years later began his government service
5 with the Department of Public Safety as a Police Officer, then later went on to fulfill
6 his real dream of being a firefighter and transferred to the Guam Fire Department,
7 where he served until his retirement in 1977; and

8 **WHEREAS**, as a Government of Guam Retiree, the late Luis Leon Guerrero
9 Paulino sought out to promote the *Chamorro* Culture by working as a Crafter at the
10 *Gef Pa'go* Cultural Center in *Inarajan*; and during his tenure there, he assisted with
11 the preparation of craft goods and local delicacies; but predominantly he shared his
12 knowledge and care for our island and heritage to visitors and locals alike; and

13 **WHEREAS**, as a consummate farmer, the late Luis Leon Guerrero Paulino
14 farmed for most of his life, and his love for working the land provided the background
15 needed to serve on the Department of Agriculture Southern Soil and Water
16 Conservation Board, to which he was appointed to by former Governor Carl T.C.
17 Gutierrez, and where he served diligently for eight (8) years from 1995 to 2003; and

18 **WHEREAS**, because of his passion and dedication to serving the people of
19 Guam, the late Luis Leon Guerrero Paulino was also appointed to the Guam Housing
20 and Urban Renewal Authority (GHURA) Board by former Governor Carl T.C.
21 Gutierrez during his two terms in office; then in 2010 was reappointed by Governor
22 Eddie J.B. Calvo. He faithfully served the GHURA Board as Vice Chairman, always
23 ensuring to attend and to be prepared for the work at hand up until his passing; and

24 **WHEREAS**, the late Luis Leon Guerrero Paulino set a commendable example
25 for his sons by living a life filled with passion for faith, family, farming, hard work,
26 dedication, and a sense of civic duty and service to the community. These attributes

1 were exemplified by an array of duties he performed, whether in an official capacity
2 or through his unselfish work; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the late Luis Leon Guerrero Paulino was a man of compassion
4 and dedication; who had a passion for helping others and the drive for continued
5 enhancement and development of “improving the island community, while upholding
6 family values”; and who’s passing will leave a void that will be felt for many years to
7 come, in both the family he loved and the island he so proudly served; now therefore,
8 be it


9 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*

17 Paulino; and to the Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'låhen Guåhan*.


