3 **WHEREAS,** the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port (Port) was
4 established as a public corporation and autonomous government agency by the
5 enactment of Public Law 13-87 in October 1975; and

1 **WHEREAS**, over the last three (3) decades, the Port has developed into a
2 major transshipment center for the Western Pacific Region, providing full services to
3 ocean passenger, cargo and fishing vessels; and

4 **WHEREAS**, in Fiscal Year 2015, the Port processed more than two million
5 one hundred ninety-one thousand eight hundred fifteen (2,191,815) revenue tons of
6 cargo, providing vital goods to the people of Guam; and

7 **WHEREAS**, three hundred fifty-five (355) Port employees operate and
8 maintain five (5) cargo handling piers, a container yard, two (2) marinas, a harbor of
9 refuge, and two (2) recreational beaches; and

10 **WHEREAS**, as part of the Guam Commercial Port Improvement (GCPI)
11 Program, the Port embarked on the Phase III container yard expansion and new
12 terminal gate complex projects, which will be completed this month; and

13 **WHEREAS**, even in the midst of undertaking improvements to modernize its
14 footprint, the Port simultaneously continues to embark upon other capital
15 improvement projects, which include implementation and integration service of its
16 terminal operating system; repair of its wharves; and improvements to its marinas, as
17 well as other facility upgrades; and


18 **WHEREAS**, the employees, management and Board of Directors of the Jose
