WHEREAS, Mr. Salas has been with the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) for over two (2) decades. He began serving there in June 1994 when he worked as a Program Coordinator II in the Division of Public Welfare, Program Management Section/Policy and Compliance, where he developed and wrote policies and procedures for the Guam Federal Food Stamp Program, administering and monitoring the Income Verification Employment System, and the Income Violation Compliance Program; and

WHEREAS, in August 1998, Mr. Salas transferred to the Division of Public Health/Bureau of Family Health and Nursing Services, where he served as a Program Coordinator III and was responsible for the Guam Title X Family Planning Grant; and where he also formulated the Title X Family Planning Budget; and he was a presenter for the Title X Family Planning Pacific Basin Conference, and he was a member of the Pacific Basin MCH Leadership Consortium. He was responsible for the Guam Newborn Metabolic Screening Program; he conducted the BFHNS in-service training to clinic/administrative staff; he conducted family planning presentations throughout the Guam Department of Education (GDOE) and at private schools; he established a partnership with the GDOE Registered Nurses for identification and prevention of teen pregnancy; he prepared requests for proposals (RFP) for contracts; he prepared end of fiscal year Finance Status Reports (FSR); he conducted staff training on the Food Stamps program, conducted "front end" investigations of the Food Stamps program, and reviewed Food Stamp recipient records for program compliance; he executed and performed "on-line" sanctions for intentional program; and he was responsible for the annual Emergency Food Stamps Training; and

WHEREAS, every year, Mr. Salas worked with the DPHSS Director on various projects to include: *Chamorro* Week; Honoring the Armed Forces Employees within the DPHSS; Liberation Day activities; Public Health Month; Worksite Wellness Programs such as: Zumba, Body Combat, and Yoga; and Adopt a School projects; and he motivated people in the Department to be active, stay healthy and enjoy working with Public Health Department; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Salas has continued to participate with the Guam Homeless Coalition "Point-in-Time" Count. He led the teams to different villages like Agat, Tamuning, Dededo, and Yigo to count the homeless; and he provided experience and knowledge with the Maternal and Child Health programs, the Newborn Screening Program, the Children with Special Health Needs Program, the Maternal Infant Early Childhood Home Visiting Programs, and of course, the Family Planning Program; and WHEREAS, Mr. Salas also worked for *Guma'Mami*, Inc., a private not-for-profit organization, where his duties included serving as a Financial Officer and a Special Projects Officer; and he reconciled financial records against general accounts, he prepared the payroll for employees; and he provided assistance at the residential group home to adults with developmental disabilities, and also served as an Acting Executive Director for the private not-for-profit organization; and

WHEREAS, from November 1971 to January 1991, Mr. Salas had served in the United States Air Force (USAF), retiring in 1991 as a Master Sergeant. During his time serving in the USAF, he performed many duties, to include Administrative Noncommissioned Officer at Headquarters, United States Air Force Global Command and Control Operations Center (the Pentagon); local area and flight following activities for senior military and civilian leadership in Washington, D.C.; and Administrative Noncommissioned Officer for the Rapid Deployment Joint Task Force (the Pentagon). He also provided administrative support services to the White House
