1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS, Mr. Raymond (Sal) Salas celebrates his retirement with his wife**
4 **of forty (40) years, Mrs. Therese Manibusan Cepeda Salas; and his three (3) children:**
5 **a daughter, Tessha, who is married to Bill Gumabon (and their children - Elijah,**
6 **Ethan, Reiko, Kenzo and Minka); a daughter, Ronisha, who is married to Rodney**

1 Duquet (and their children Elijah, Serena and Xavier); and a son, Teron, who is
2 married to Rosemarie Hormillosa; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Salas has been with the Department of Public Health and
4 Social Services (DPHSS) for over two (2) decades. He began serving there in June
5 1994 when he worked as a Program Coordinator II in the Division of Public Welfare,
6 Program Management Section/Policy and Compliance, where he developed and wrote
7 policies and procedures for the Guam Federal Food Stamp Program, administering
8 and monitoring the Income Verification Employment System, and the Income
9 Violation Compliance Program; and

10 **WHEREAS**, in August 1998, Mr. Salas transferred to the Division of Public
11 Health/Bureau of Family Health and Nursing Services, where he served as a Program
12 Coordinator III and was responsible for the Guam Title X Family Planning Grant; and
13 where he also formulated the Title X Family Planning Budget; and he was a presenter
14 for the Title X Family Planning Pacific Basin Conference, and he was a member of
15 the Pacific Basin MCH Leadership Consortium. He was responsible for the Guam
16 Newborn Metabolic Screening Program; he conducted the BFHNS in-service training
17 to clinic/administrative staff; he conducted family planning presentations throughout
18 the Guam Department of Education (GDOE) and at private schools; he established a
19 partnership with the GDOE Registered Nurses for identification and prevention of
20 teen pregnancy; he prepared requests for proposals (RFP) for contracts; he prepared
21 end of fiscal year Finance Status Reports (FSR); he conducted staff training on the
22 Food Stamps program, conducted “front end” investigations of the Food Stamps
23 program, and reviewed Food Stamp recipient records for program compliance; he
24 executed and performed “on-line” sanctions for intentional program; and he was
25 responsible for the annual Emergency Food Stamps Training; and

1 **WHEREAS**, every year, Mr. Salas worked with the DPHSS Director on
2 various projects to include: *Chamorro* Week; Honoring the Armed Forces Employees
3 within the DPHSS; Liberation Day activities; Public Health Month; Worksite
4 Wellness Programs such as: Zumba, Body Combat, and Yoga; and Adopt a School
5 projects; and he motivated people in the Department to be active, stay healthy and
6 enjoy working with Public Health Department; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Salas has continued to participate with the Guam Homeless
8 Coalition “Point-in-Time” Count. He led the teams to different villages like Agat,
9 Tamuning, Dededo, and Yigo to count the homeless; and he provided experience and
10 knowledge with the Maternal and Child Health programs, the Newborn Screening
11 Program, the Children with Special Health Needs Program, the Maternal Infant Early
12 Childhood Home Visiting Programs, and of course, the Family Planning Program; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Salas also worked for *Guma’Mami*, Inc., a private not-for-
14 profit organization, where his duties included serving as a Financial Officer and a
15 Special Projects Officer; and he reconciled financial records against general accounts,
16 he prepared the payroll for employees; and he provided assistance at the residential
17 group home to adults with developmental disabilities, and also served as an Acting
18 Executive Director for the private not-for-profit organization; and

19 **WHEREAS**, from November 1971 to January 1991, Mr. Salas had served in
20 the United States Air Force (USAF), retiring in 1991 as a Master Sergeant. During his
21 time serving in the USAF, he performed many duties, to include Administrative
22 Noncommissioned Officer at Headquarters, United States Air Force Global Command
23 and Control Operations Center (the Pentagon); local area and flight following
24 activities for senior military and civilian leadership in Washington, D.C.; and
25 Administrative Noncommissioned Officer for the Rapid Deployment Joint Task Force
26 (the Pentagon). He also provided administrative support services to the White House

1 Advance Office operation deployed; Noncommissioned Officer-In-Charge (NCO) for
2 the Weapons and Tactics/Standardization and Evaluation, the United States Logistics
3 Group Fighter Operations Flying Wing; Administrative Superintendent and Senior
4 Noncommissioned Officer in Charge for the Bomber and Tanker Strategic Operations
5 assigned to the Deputy Commander for Operations; forward deployed Chief of
6 Administration and personnel manager for the Strategic Air Command Advanced
7 Echelon forces; Operations and Plans Noncommissioned Officer-In-Charge,
8 Intelligence Division, and Reconnaissance Strategic Wing; and he performed duties as
9 the Superintendent for the forward operating base Strategic Air Command Flying
10 Operations; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Salas provided a great deal of guidance with his military
12 experience by guiding the BFHNS Disaster and Emergency Preparedness drills and
13 exercises such as, the GIAA Aircraft Drills, the H1N1 Immunization Drills, the
14 typhoon events, the Top of Four Radiological Drill, and all hazard drills; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Salas is a jack-of-all-trades for the Bureau, and he will never
16 be forgotten for his service as its Office Manager, Certificate Specialist, Forms
17 Creator, Traffic Control, Security Guard, Raincoat Man, Supply Tech, Inventory
18 Expert, Fire Drill Sergeant, its Greeter, Tour Guide, Zumba Instructor, Chamorro
19 Cook, its Guam and DPHSS Historian, Life Guard, Senior Advisor, Immunization
20 Controller, Newborn Screening Manager, Disability Advisor, and Family Planning
21 Coordinator; and he still continues to motivate his staff to exercise daily with the
22 Worksite Wellness Program; now therefore, be it

4 further


5 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
