1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN***  
2 ***GUÅHAN*:**

3        **WHEREAS,** the Lions Club International is the world's largest service club  
4 organization, with forty-six thousand (46,000) clubs and more than one million four  
5 hundred thousand (1,400,000) members throughout the world; and

1           **WHEREAS**, among the programs within the Lions Club International umbrella  
2 are youth and young adult groups that provide organized service opportunities for high  
3 school students through the Leo Clubs; and those out of high school up to age thirty  
4 (30) through the Leo Lions Clubs; and

5           **WHEREAS**, on November 3, 1998, the Guam Harmony Lions Club was  
6 chartered within the Lions Club International District 204, with twenty-four (24)  
7 members; and it selected cancer awareness as its special project; and

8           **WHEREAS**, the Guam Harmony Lions Club now has forty-three (43)  
9 members whose occupations range from business, medicine, education, government,  
10 the arts, and homemaking; and

11           **WHEREAS**, the commonality among this diverse membership is the desire to  
12 better serve the community through the collective efforts of the club members; and

13           **WHEREAS**, the Guam Harmony Lions Club has promoted the culture of  
14 community service for our youth by sponsoring two (2) Leo Clubs, comprised of  
15 students from Southern High School; and in so doing, they have provided a means for  
16 these students to engage in their own service projects, and to join with their adult  
17 counterparts in joint projects, as well; and

18           **WHEREAS**, among the joint projects of the Guam Harmony Lions Club and  
19 its sponsored Leo Clubs are their participation in medical health fairs, the district-wide  
20 Leo campout, and the adoption and maintenance of two (2) bus stops in *Asan*; and

21           **WHEREAS**, through its focus on cancer awareness and those afflicted with the  
22 disease, the Guam Harmony Lions Club has, over the years, made annual monetary  
23 donations to the American Cancer Society; they visited and delivered fruit baskets to  
24 cancer patients; and they have provided financial assistance to cancer patients for  
25 treatment both on and off-island; and

1           **WHEREAS**, aside from its important work in the areas of cancer awareness  
2 and youth leadership and service, the Guam Harmony Lions Club engages in  
3 community development and improvement activities, such as: the annual coastal  
4 cleanup; planting trees at *Adacao* Elementary School and *Asan* Beach Park; the  
5 Diabetes Awareness Wave; the Airport Road cleanup; and feeding and providing  
6 entertainment to over one thousand (1,000) homeless people at the annual Salvation  
7 Army Thanksgiving Day celebration; and

8           **WHEREAS**, the Guam Harmony Lions Club’s activities extend beyond  
9 Guam’s borders with the club twinning with the Seven Lakes Lions Club in the  
10 Republic of the Philippines, to provide donations to help the typhoon victims in  
11 Saipan, Chuuk, Yap, and the Philippines; and

12           **WHEREAS**, Guam and the Guam Harmony Lions Club have been well  
13 represented in international conventions and forums where the Guam Harmony Lions  
14 Club had received international recognition for its programs and activities; and

15           **WHEREAS**, on October 25, 2015, the Guam Harmony Lions Club will  
16 celebrate the Seventeenth (17<sup>th</sup>) Year Anniversary of its chartering; and

17           **WHEREAS**, along with the celebration of its anniversary, the Guam Harmony  
18 Lions Club will also celebrate the significant achievement of standing as a sponsor of  
19 the Guam Serenity Lions Club, the first Leo Lions Club in District 204, and whose  
20 members include twenty-four (24) former members of the Guam Harmony Lions  
21 Club, Leo Club II, and young adults from the University of Guam; and

22           **WHEREAS**, the organizer of the Guam Serenity Lions Club is Lion Lynda  
23 Tolan, First Vice District Governor, and the Charter President of the Guam Harmony  
24 Lions Club who, together with Lion Nilda Estampador, will serve as Guiding Lions  
25 for the next two (2) years; now therefore be it

2 on behalf of the people of Guam, congratulate the Guam Harmony Lions Club on the

5 people; and does further commend the Guam Harmony Lions Club for its sponsorship

7 Club International District 204; and be it further


8           **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to,
