1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN***
2 ***GUÅHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS**, in December 2001, Michael Lamme first arrived on Guam from
4 Minnesota while performing his duties as a Machinist's Mate on the USS Frank
5 Cable; and

1 **WHEREAS**, while living on Guam, Michael Lammey met Rose Concepcion,
2 who became his wife; and he became the father of three (3) daughters: Francine,
3 Alexis and Mackenzie; and

4 **WHEREAS**, in December 2006, Michael Lammey survived a steam line leak
5 rupture that led to an explosion in the boiler room on the USS Frank Cable; and
6 Michael endured third degree burns to fifty-five percent (55%) of his body, as well as
7 fifty (50) surgeries, with dozens pending; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Michael Lammey’s injuries qualified him to receive specialized
9 care through the University of California, Los Angeles Operation Mend program,
10 offering care at no cost to servicemen and women, and giving solace to his family
11 during his care; and

12 **WHEREAS**, in 2007, Michael Lammey received the U.S. Navy and Marine
13 Corps Commendation Medals for “heroic” action in helping others to safety; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Michael Lammey was enrolled in the Navy Safe Harbor program,
15 which assists seriously wounded, ill, or injured Sailors and Coast Guardsmen with
16 their recovery, rehabilitation, and reintegration, where he began his studies in safety
17 courses; and

18 **WHEREAS**, during the Navy Safe Harbor annual awards ceremony in 2010,
19 Michael and Rose Lammey were honored for their strength and heroism facing
20 tremendous adversity; and

21 **WHEREAS**, through the Navy Safe Harbor program, Michael Lammey
22 received an opportunity to join the Naval Sea Systems Command Safety team; and

23 **WHEREAS**, Michael Lammey used this opportunity to study safety issues in-
24 depth, spending fifteen (15) weeks at the Army Safety Center studying over fifty-one
25 (51) different safety courses in the intensive CP-12 Certification Program; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Michael Lammey realized his new mission in his life was to be an
2 advocate for safety in the workplace having understood the dangers that complacency
3 and a false sense of security has on workplace safety protocol; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Michael Lammey created the Safety Happens, LLC, to share his
5 experience and knowledge to all industries. The Safety Happens Seminar has reached
6 dozens of organizations cautioning its managers of the financial and emotional toll
7 that comes from workplace accidents. Safety Happens, LLC, has helped tens of
8 thousands of managers and non-managers to clarify, strengthen, and implement a
9 culture of personal responsibility of safety in the workplace; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Michael Lammey brings his sought after Safety Happens Seminar
11 to Guam, reminding our community about the importance of workplace safety and the
12 responsibility of every employee to be proactive in order to prevent serious injuries in
13 the workplace; now therefore, be it

14 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
15 on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and welcome back to Guam Mr. Michael
16 Lammey of Safety Happens, LLC; and does further extend *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os*
17 *Ma'åse'* to him for his courage and for using his experience and voice to advocate for
18 safe workplaces through the Safety Happens Seminar; and be it further
