3 **WHEREAS**, a group of one hundred fifty-nine (159) high school students and
4 their advisors from Japan will be visiting Guam for the purpose of showing respect
5 and to offer prayers for those who died during World War II; and

1 **WHEREAS**, on November 11, 2015, the Principal, Teachers, and Students of
2 *Kanagawa Prefectural, Hiratsuka High School* from Japan will be visiting World War
3 II related sites on Guam, including the War in the Pacific National Park and the
4 *Manenggon Memorial Park*, in order to better understand the horrors of war and its
5 effects on both the soldiers who fought it and the innocent civilians caught in its wake;

7 **WHEREAS**, it is hoped that this will continue to be an annual trip, and that the
8 tribute paid by these high school students will shine as an example that will encourage
9 other students and organizations from Japan to make similar trips; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the U.S. Explore and Study, Inc. has been instrumental in trying
11 to heal the wounds of World War II and tensions over the war between the people of
12 Japan, Guam, and the United States, and has held ceremonies and tributes in the past
13 years with that noble aim; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the U.S. Explore & Study, Inc., along with its President Mr.
15 Kensuke Haga, have worked extremely hard to move towards these goals and
16 especially to help organize this trip by Japanese high school students; now therefore,
17 be it

18 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina' Trentai Tres Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
19 on behalf of the people of Guam, highly commend the Principal, Teachers, and
20 Students of *Kanagawa Prefectural, Hiratsuka High School* from Japan for visiting

23 continued dedication and hard work on the project; and be it further


24 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to,
