BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN: WHEREAS, Hiroyuki Miyata was born in Gifu Prefecture, Japan; and WHEREAS, after graduating from Waseda University, Hiroyuki Miyata began working for the Japanese construction conglomerate Sumitomo Construction, which is

now the Sumitomo Matsui Construction Co., Ltd.; and

1 WHEREAS, in the late 1980s, Hiroyuki Miyata first came to Guam to work as 2 a Sales Manager for Sumitomo Construction; and 3 WHEREAS, Hiroyuki Miyata helped to scout for available land on Guam for development of the LeoPalace Resort Guam project, acquiring land from the late 4 Texas rancher Harold Dwight Look, Hiroyuki Miyata coordinated the LeoPalace 5 Resort Guam project until construction began in 1989; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Hiroyuki Miyata was recalled back to Sumitomo's headquarters in Japan where he worked for five years as Secretary to the President of Sumitomo 8 9 Construction, another five years as head of Sumitomo's Human Resource Department, 10 and a year as Branch Manager in Nagoya before he was appointed to directorship of 11 the company; and 12 WHEREAS, in 2003, Hiroyuki Miyata became the third President of what is now Sumitomo Mitsui Construction Co., Ltd. He had also served as a Vice Chairman 13 14 at Sumitomo before he was asked to join LeoPalace 21; and 15 WHEREAS, in 2008, he became Senior Managing Director for LeoPalace 21; 16 and 17 WHEREAS, in July 2013, Hiroyuki Miyata moved back to Guam to serve as 18 the President and CEO of the LeoPalace Guam Corporation; and he was responsible 19 for 1,310 acres of land and property in the hills of Yona; and 20 WHEREAS, Hiroyuki Miyata was determined to rejuvenate the sprawling 21 resort by increasing the level of activity at the LeoPalace Resort Guam, and attracting 22 new visitors and the local and military population to the resort; and 23 WHEREAS, Hiroyuki Miyata was also committed to bringing in more tourists

WHEREAS, Hiroyuki Miyata saw potential in several bourgeoning tourist

by exploring the opportunities that Guam had to offer; and

markets, including health and wellness tourism, education tourism, family tourism,

- WHEREAS, the LeoPalace Resort Guam has brought in athletes from around
- 4 the region for training and competition. The resort added a Jack Nicklaus Academy of
- 5 Golf; and in August 2015, the resort hosted the inaugural Guam Women's Baseball
- 6 Cup bringing to Guam teams from Taiwan, Hong Kong, South Korea, and Japan; and
- WHEREAS, the LeoPalace Resort Guam has hosted ten (10) companies from
- 8 the region, bringing in business professionals from the region for meetings or
- 9 incentive travel; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the LeoPalace Resort Guam is working to bring additional new
- amenities to its resort to meet new travel trends in the region, including new health
- 12 and wellness facilities for athletes, accommodations for longer stays, and senior care
- 13 facilities; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Hiroyuki Miyata had worked with the University of Guam to
- build education tourism opportunities, and also worked to establish ties between
- 16 universities in Japan and the University of Guam. The LeoPalace Resort Guam has
- 17 housed at its resort three to four hundred students who were visiting the University of
- 18 Guam; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Hiroyuki Miyata has shared his knowledge and expertise with the
- 20 people of Guam, contributing his time to serve as a member of the Greater China
- 21 Committee for the Guam Visitors Bureau; and
- WHEREAS, in 2014, Hiroyuki Miyata was nominated for Guam Business
- 23 Magazine Executive of the Year award, emphasizing the magnitude of his work while
- residing on the island for just a short amount of time; and

WHEREAS, Hiroyuki Miyata's many contributions and accomplishments has
laid the groundwork for diversifying Guam's tourism industry that will benefit our
economy and the people of Guam for many years to come; now therefore, be it
