1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***  
2        ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN:***

3        **WHEREAS, Mr. Emelio Yu Uy was born on November 11, 1950, in the city of**  
4        **Manila, Philippines; and is the son of Mr. Lino H. Uy and Mrs. So Ching Uy. He is**

1 the second son of seven children; and his siblings are Rosy, Vicky, Alfredo, Ben,  
2 Ramon, and Anderson; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Emelio Yu Uy attended Elementary School, Junior High  
4 School and Senior High School at Saint Stephen's School in Magdalena, Santa Cruz,  
5 Manila, Philippines. He received his Bachelor of Science degree in Commerce,  
6 majoring in Accounting, as a graduate of the Class of 1971 at the University of Santo  
7 Tomas in Metro Manila, Philippines; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Emelio Yu Uy has been a resident of Guam for more than  
9 twenty-two (22) years, and has served as a businessman and civic leader. He continues  
10 to have a strong socio-civic involvement that has helped the community of Guam.  
11 Despite his hectic schedule attending to his business and other civic activities, Emelio  
12 has been involved in almost all prestigious local charitable organizations; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Emelio Yu Uy has brought many basketball players to Guam  
14 from the Philippines, South Korea, and Taiwan for International Invitational  
15 Friendship Tournaments to help raise funds for scholarships for deserving athletes at  
16 the University of Guam. The event has also fostered goodwill between Guam, the  
17 Philippines, South Korea, and Taiwan; and at the same time has given a taste of a  
18 local favorite spectator sport; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Emelio Yu Uy was responsible for bringing many outstanding  
20 visitors to Guam from the Philippines, including President Corazon Aquino, President  
21 Fidel Ramos, former Chief Justice of Philippines Andres Narvasa, Richard Gordon,  
22 Marcelo Fernan, Speaker Jose De Venecia, Senator Gringo Honasan, Senator Loren  
23 Legarda, Senator Edgardo Angara, Vice President Teofisto Guingona, Justice Josue  
24 Bellosillo, and Quezon City Mayor Mel Mathay for the sister-city signing between the  
25 Philippines and Guam, an event that has grown stronger as the interaction between

1 these Philippines leaders and the leaders of the Guam has led to a better understanding  
2 of relationships between our two communities; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Emelio Yu Uy has also helped to entertain the music lovers on  
4 Guam by bringing to Guam a constant stream of well-known Filipino entertainers,  
5 such as German Moreno, Gary Valenciano, Dessa, Joey Albert, Ivy Violan, Martin  
6 Nievera, the Apo Hiking Society, Rannie Raymundo, Dulce, Nonoy Zuniga, Arnel  
7 Ignacio, Gabby Concepcion, Robin Padilla, Jessa Zaragosa, Dingdong Avanzado,  
8 Giselle Sanchez, Jean Garcia, Piolo Pascual, Judy Ann Santos, Marvin Agustin,  
9 Jericho Rosales, the late Rico Yan, Agot Isidro, Amy Perez, Dominic Ochoa, Jolina  
10 Magdangal, Mylene Dizon, Willie Revillame, Sarah Geronimo, Mark Bautista, Billy  
11 Joe Crawford, Charlie Green, Regine Velasquez, Ogie Alcasid, Dingdong Dantes,  
12 Marian Rivera, Manny Pacquiao, and many other well-known artists; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Emelio Yu Uy has also been very committed and dedicated to  
14 community work since his arrival on Guam with his partaking in the government of  
15 Guam, serving as Director of the Guam Museum Foundation; the A.B. Won Pat Guam  
16 International Airport Authority (2005 to 2007); and served as the Guam Visitors  
17 Bureau Fundraising and Finance Chairman of the Guam Delegation to the Pacific Arts  
18 Festival (FESTPAC) 1996 Delegation to Apia, Western Samoa; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Emelio Yu Uy has also committed a lot of his time to assisting  
20 the community in civic duties as the President of the Filipino Community of Guam  
21 (FCG) for two (2) terms (1998, 2001-2002), as Chairman of the Board of Trustees; as  
22 an Advisor, Philippine Independence Celebration; as an Executive Committee  
23 Chairman, Ways and Means, and Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Lions Club  
24 District 2014, and the Lions International: Past District Governor; Former President of  
25 Guåhan Lions Club; former District Cabinet Treasurer; adviser to the Guåhan Lions  
26 Club, and charter member of Guåhan Lions Club; current District 204 Extension

1 Chair; the Fil-Am Chamber of Commerce; the Fil-Am Tennis Association of Guam;  
2 the Filipino Cultural Center (Eskuwelahan Munti); the Fil-Guam Charities  
3 Foundation, Inc.; the Guam Filipino Artists; the Kundirana Guam Charity  
4 Association; the Sining Kayumanggi Chorale; the University of Santo Tomas Alumni  
5 Organization of Guam; the American Red Cross; Beauty World Guam Ltd.; the Guam  
6 Beautification Association of Guam; the Guam Chamber of Commerce; the Guam  
7 Lytico-Bodig Association; the Make-a-Wish Foundation, Guam Chapter; the  
8 Marianas Association for Retarded Citizens; Sanctuary, Inc.; the University of Guam  
9 Intercollegiate Council; and Chinese Chamber of Commerce of Guam, and United

17 Products of the Philippines, *Tamuning*, Guam; Vice-President and Board of Director,  
18 Benison Corporation of Guam, DBA: The Fun Fair Arcade Guam, *Dededo*, Guam;

20 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Emelio Yu Uy has received many recognitions and awards

11 Philippines 2008 Outstanding Filipino-Americans Award; and


12 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Emelio Yu Uy also received numerous awards in the U.S.

8 with best wishes for many more to come; and be it further


9       **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules


