- 3 WHEREAS, in 1975, the Guam Football (Soccer) Association (GFA) was
- 4 founded to establish recreational football on Guam; and
- WHEREAS, a few years after the founding of the Guam Football Association,
- 6 military leagues sprang up for youth teams; and

WHEREAS, in 1991, the Guam Football Association became an associate

2 member of the Asian Football Confederation (AFC); and

WHEREAS, in 1996, the Guam Football Association was recommended to have full membership in the *Federation Internationale de Football Association* (FIFA), and it was voted in as a member at the FIFA Congress in Zurich, attaining full membership in the Asian Football Confederation; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Football Association has forged relationships with regional neighbors and foreign coaches to assist Guam's national teams in preparation for regular international competitions, which is necessary for the continual improvement of the Guam national teams; and

WHEREAS, Guam has participated in the U14 festivals and tournaments, the U16 tournaments, the U19 tournaments, the Women's Asian Championships, the Challenge Cup Qualifying Events, the World Cup Qualifying Events, and the Club Championships; and it participates in the East Asian Games, which are held every four (4) years; and

WHEREAS, Guam teams have participated in events in the Philippines, Japan, Korea, Vietnam, China, Myanmar, Iran, Nepal, Tahiti, Papua New Guinea, Vanuatu, Fiji, and Palau, among other countries; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Football Association has collaborated with the government of Guam through public-private partnerships to develop more football fields and stadiums to benefit the athletes and people of Guam; and

WHEREAS, in 1997, Public Law 24-33 authorized the development of land in *Dededo* for a soccer stadium that now serves as the Guam Football Association National Training Center Field; and

WHEREAS, in 2009, owing to the success of Public Law 24-33, Public Law 30-3 authorized land in *Agat* to be developed into a Southern Sports Complex; and

WHEREAS, the development of these fields and stadiums will better serve the athletes and people of Guam by encouraging them to live healthy and active lives and to become great team players; and

WHEREAS, in 2012, Gary J. White became the newly appointed Head Coach and the Federation's Technical Director, and he developed the Guam Football

and the Federation's Technical Director, and he developed the Guam Football Association National Academy to better hone the skills of promising young athletes on Guam and enable them to live healthy lives; and

WHEREAS, Head Coach Gary J. White is assisted by Sang Hoon Kim, the GFA's Assistant Technical Director and Head Coach of the Guam Women's National Team, which is called *Maskada*. Sang Hoon Kim was an assistant coach with the highly decorated professional club team Ulsan Hyundai in the K-League; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Football Association strives for excellence and has adopted a ten (10)-year football development plan called, the "Fifth Element Project 2022" outlining the necessary areas of improvement to become a fifth-ranked team in national rankings, as well as in coaching, officiating, youth, and political development in East Asia; and

WHEREAS, in August 2015, the success of this plan could be seen clearly as the Guam National Team "*Matao*" reached its highest FIFA ranking of 146 after their victory against Turkmenistan and India; and

WHEREAS, the Guam National Team's victory over India brought global exposure to Guam and presented opportunities through sports tourism on Guam, and it also brought pride among the people of Guam and solidified Guam as a serious contender in football; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Football Association is comprised of twenty-two (22) teams in the men's league competing for the coveted Guam Football Association Cup, the Guam Football Association's Beach Soccer League, and the Futsal League; and

WHEREAS, there are currently six (6) women's teams playing in various leagues, and with the creation of the recreational Guam Football Association Soccer Moms League and the Women's Intermediate 7-A-Slide Recreational League, the number of registered female players has doubled; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Football Association oversees over one thousand (1000) youth athletes in six (6) divisions, U6, U8, U10, U12, U14, and U17; and one hundred (100) teams from thirteen (13) clubs who participate in the Youth Leagues; and

WHEREAS, these leagues and clubs owe a lot to the dedicated volunteers, parents, athletes, and children who are determined to grow the sport at a grassroots level; and

WHEREAS, with the Guam Football Association's commitment to grow football and increase the quality of the sport on Guam, the Guam Football Association regularly holds a GFA "E" Coaching Certificate course and a GFA "D" Coaching License course for club coaches to develop, as well as coordinating FIFA and AFC courses in coaching and officiating for the local community; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Football Association's commitment to the island also extends into reducing its impact on Guam's environment by reducing water usage through the installation of two (2) full-size artificial turf pitches and an artificial turf mini-pitch, and turning to solar energy by engaging in the operation of a solar energy farm; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Football Association has been recognized globally as a model organization for their commitment to fast-track growth and development in football, and the overall increased popularity of the sport on Guam; and
