WHEREAS, Mrs. Francisca Damian Quenga was born on August 21, 1936;

and she is the daughter of †Engracio Bodesein Damian and †Maria Sablan Damian;

WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Quenga were blessed with five (5) beautiful children: Anthony, Jesse, Raymond, Anna Marie and Patrick; fourteen (14) wonderful grandchildren, and thirteen (13) great-grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, their "Love Story" started in 1954 when "Ton" was stationed in Korea and was planning to travel back home to Guam. He met a cousin of Francisca and explained that when he left Guam he had no girlfriend or anyone special in his life; and Francisca's cousin showed him a picture and asked him to choose which cousin he would like to write to, and from there Ton said "this is the one I want" choosing Francisca as his heart's desire; and

WHEREAS, Ton started writing to her, but she never responded because she didn't know him, and he later sent her a package containing twelve (12) neckerchiefs and a set of fountain pens; and

WHEREAS, a week later, when Francisca went to work, a co-worker said, "Frances, there's a good-looking man in an Army uniform with curly hair and one gold tooth asking for you." She said she didn't know him, and her co-worker told her that he will be back later to see her. When he came back to see her for lunch, he told her, "I'm the one who's been writing to you," and with her shy demeanor she replied, "ok." He invited her to sit with him and talk. He then told her that he wanted her to be his wife. She told him "I will wait for you until you return home"; and

WHEREAS, the morning before he was to leave Guam, Ton went to say his final good-bye to Frances, who was attending Mass at St. Anthony Church. He walked her home and kissed her good-bye; and

WHEREAS, after a year he returned home and told Frances he was going to reenlist and take her to Germany, but her father said to wait for another year, so instead he went on to work for the U.S. Navy Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, a week after they married, Antonio picked up his paycheck and told Frances "from now on, you will handle everything." Until this day, Antonio does not know their bank account number or how much money they have. He insisted that Frances deserves the best and he made sure that she was always taken care of. He always told her he loved her; and

WHEREAS, after two (2) years of marriage, Antonio joined the U.S. Navy, and at the time they had a son, Anthony, and another child on the way. Francisca had worked as a cashier for forty (40) years at the Guam Department Store, Ada's Enterprises in *Agaña*, the Piggly Wiggly in Louisiana, and the Navy Exchange in Newport, Rhode Island; and

WHEREAS, Antonio and Francisca went on to have five (5) children, who were well-educated and were raised to be independent individuals. Mr. and Mrs. Quenga were strict parents, and they wanted their children to be well-mannered and respectful. The Quenga household had many chores and rules for the children to follow. When mopping the floors, the kids had to do them on their knees, just like Dad did on the Navy ships. Each child had a curfew and they were only able to go out on Saturday nights until 9:00 p.m. because they attended mass early the next morning. After each child graduated high school, both parents hugged them and told them, "we raised you up the best we know how, join the military and educate yourself before making any commitments." All four (4) of their sons, Anthony, Jesse, Patrick and

1 Raymond joined the military; Raymond went into the telecommunications field; and

2 Anna received her Masters degree in Education; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Quenga, being a military wife for many years, said it wasn't

easy, but she did what she needed to do and thanked God every day for guiding her

through it all. They are both happy that their children are successful in life and have
