1           **WHEREAS**, among the stated purposes of Lions Clubs International are: to  
2 create and foster a spirit of understanding among the peoples of the world; to promote  
3 the principles of good government and good citizenship; to take an active interest in  
4 the civic, cultural, social and moral welfare of the community; and to encourage  
5 service-minded people to serve their community without personal financial reward;

7           **WHEREAS**, the Lions Clubs on Guam stay true to the purpose and ethics of  
8 Lions Clubs International, and their many activities have served to strengthen our  
9 community as a whole and make profound differences in the lives of individuals both  
10 on Guam and abroad; and

11           **WHEREAS**, on the occasion of the Lions Clubs International District 204  
12 Christmas Party held on December 13, 2015, the District welcomes to Guam Lions  
13 Clubs International First Vice President, Chancellor Bob Corlew and his wife, Diane,  
14 who are on Guam to meet the Lions of District 204, to share their experiences as  
15 Lions, and to help strengthen the Lions Clubs on Guam; and

16           **WHEREAS**, First Vice President Bob Corlew is from Milton, Tennessee; and  
17 he taught at the Nashville School of Law, from 1999 to 2014; he served as a Judge for

23 President, Zone Chairperson, District Governor, and Cabinet Secretary; and

2 his service as a Lion and has received numerous awards, including: the Leadership  
3 Award, the Builder Key Award, three (3) International President's Awards, and the  
4 Ambassador of Good Will Award, the highest honor the Association bestows upon its  
5 members; and

6           **WHEREAS**, First Vice President Bob Corlew is also a Vanguard of the Melvin  
7 Jones Memorial, a Progressive Lindsey-Jennings Fellow, and a Progressive Melvin  
8 Jones Fellow; and

9           **WHEREAS**, First Vice President Bob Corlew has also been active in other  
10 organizations, such as the Boy Scouts of America, the Jaycees, and the American Red  
11 Cross; and


12           **WHEREAS**, First Vice President Bob Corlew had also served as a Councilman  
13 in Milton, Tennessee; and he served as a Major in the U.S Army Reserve; now  
14 therefore, be it
