- 3 WHEREAS, Jack Santos Shimizu was born on March 23, 1940; and is the son
- 4 of †Joaquin Torres Shimizu and †Ana Santos Shimizu. He was raised in the village of
- 5 Dededo and was a member of the first graduating class of Santa Barbara Catholic
- 6 School; and

WHEREAS, as a young child, Jack survived the Japanese occupation of Guam 1 2 during World War II and was a member of Guam's greatest generation; and WHEREAS, Jack joined the United States Navy in 1957 at the young age of 3 seventeen (17), and he served in the U.S. Navy for twenty-eight (28) years. His tours 4 of duty included serving on amphibious ships, guided missile cruisers, and at the U.S. 5 Navy Military Personnel Command in Washington, D.C. His first combat tour was 6 serving in the Vietnam War, from 1965 to 1966; and his second tour was in 1969 and 7 1970 again in Vietnam; and 8 WHEREAS, Jack was assigned to the River Assault Squadron 13 and 15, 9 where he served as a U.S. Navy Boat Captain on the Mekong Delta, and he received a 10 11 Purple Heart Medal in December 1970 after being injured while on patrol; and 12 WHEREAS, after serving for twenty-eight (28) years in the U.S. Navy, Jack retired as a Master Chief Petty Officer in July 1985. Upon retiring, he returned to 13 Guam and settled in the village of Mangilao with his family. He continued a life of 14 service to our community and served in several major positions of the government of 15 16 Guam, to include being appointed to serve as the Chief of Police of the Guam Police 17 Department and the Director of the Guam Department of Corrections; and WHEREAS, Jack is prominently remembered for his dedication and time in 18 helping other military Veterans. He was instrumental in the founding of the Guam 19 20 Chapter of the Military Order of the Purple Heart (MOPH), and he had served as the 21 Pacific Commander of the organization. He was steadfast in carrying out the mission of the MOPH to advocate solidarity and camaraderie among combat wounded 22 Veterans, supporting necessary legislative initiatives, and above all, providing aid and 23 support to all Veterans and their families; and 24 25 WHEREAS, Jack was active in promoting the organization to Purple Heart

recipients and making them aware of the services that were available to them. He and

other MOPH members visited homebound residents to assess their needs and offer

2 assistance. He would also take the lead and organized fundraising events to assist

other charitable organizations, and he volunteered much of his time to help at the
