4 Studies from Central Texas College in May of 1988, and later completed an
5 Associate’s Degree in Applied Management from the same college in August of 1993;
6 and he is currently enrolled with the University of Maryland’s Business
7 Administration Program; and

8 **WHEREAS**, additionally, CW5 Francis A. Pablo completed numerous military
9 education and training programs throughout his nearly four (4) decades of military
10 service, including courses for Non-Commissioned Officers Advance—and Warrant
11 Officer Senior Staff; and

12 **WHEREAS**, CW5 Francis A. Pablo’s military career reflects extensive
13 experiences in administrative and leadership positions including Infantryman (1978-
14 1981) at Fort Carson, Colorado; Personnel Records Specialist (1981-1985) at Fort
15 Clayton, Republic of Panama; Legal Specialist at Fort Juan Muña, Guam Territorial
16 Command (GTC); Unit Administrative NCO – 838th Medical Company at Fort Juan
17 Muña, Guam; Line of Duty/Incapacitation Officer (1992-1993); State Security
18 Manager (1993-1995); Personnel Service Center Unit Chief (1995-1996);
19 Education/MGIB/LOD/INCAP/ACME Officer (1996-2001); Quality Assurance/Staff
20 Accountant (2000-2003) Finance-USPFO; Army National Guard Bureau Evaluation
21 Section/ARP/Action Branch Chief (2003-2004); National Guard Bureau Board
22 Section Chief (2005-2006); National Guard Bureau/ARH/Police Chief Warrant
23 Officer (2006-2007); and Command Chief Warrant Officer – Guam Army National
24 Guard (2007-2016) ; and

25 **WHEREAS**, CW5 Francis A. Pablo’s leadership and steadfast commitment to
26 service have earned him great admiration, as well as appropriate recognition by his

1 superiors, including the Meritorious Service Medal (5th Oak Leaf Cluster), the Army
2 Commendation Medal (4th Oak Leaf Cluster), the Army Achievement Medal (3rd Oak
3 Leaf Cluster), the Army Good Conduct Medal (4th Award), the Army Reserve
4 Components Achievement Medal (3rd Oak Leaf Cluster), the National Defense
5 Service Medal (1st Award), the Humanitarian Service Medal (1st Award), the Armed
6 Forces Reserve Medal – NCO Professional Development Ribbon (Numeral-3), the
7 Army Service Ribbon, and the Overseas Service Ribbon; and

8 **WHEREAS**, in his thirty-seven (37) years of military service with the U.S.
9 Armed Forces, CW5 Francis A. Pablo has answered each and every call to duty since
10 his early years as an Infantryman and Personnel Action NCO, to his current tenure as
11 the Command Chief Warrant Officer. He had worked tirelessly to help move the
12 mission of the Guam Army National Guard forward; and in doing so, he has inspired

23 Inspector General in Washington, D.C.; and be it further


24 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules


