- 5 April 2009, and by Governor Eddie Baza Calvo in January 2011; and

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- WHEREAS, as an individual who has truly gone above and beyond the call of duty to excel in his career and give back to his community, Mr. Pinauin has made a difference in the lives of many people with his dedication to public service; and
