1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** it is the sense of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* (the Guam Legislature) to
4 commend members of the community whose diligent service has considerably
5 contributed to the well-being of the public; and

1 **WHEREAS**, attendant to such concern, and in full accord with its long-
2 standing traditions, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* is justly proud to honor Mr. Manuel R.
3 Pinauin on the occasion of his retirement from the Guam Civil Service Commission
4 (CSC), to be celebrated on Thursday, December 31, 2015; and

5 **WHEREAS**, affectionately known as “Manny” to those who worked closely
6 with him, Mr. Pinauin received his Associate of Science in Land Surveying degree
7 and his Bachelor of Science in Geodetic Engineering degree from the Manuel L.
8 Quezon School of Engineering and Architecture in Manila, Philippines, in 1959; and

9 **WHEREAS**, before his work with the CSC, Mr. Pinauin began his forty (40)
10 years of civil service working as a Construction Management Engineer for the Naval
11 Facilities Engineering Command (NAVFAC) in February 1968; and subsequently, he
12 also served as the Officer-in-Charge of Construction (OICC) Marianas for Guam and
13 the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands (TTPI) from February 1981 to September
14 1984; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Pinauin received numerous accolades and awards while
16 serving as a Construction Management Engineer, including Certificates of Award
17 from OICC Marianas for “Outstanding Performance” as Construction Management
18 Engineer from 1984 to 1999; a Certificate of Appreciation from the 9th Regional
19 Support Command for “Outstanding and Meritorious Service” in 2004; and a U.S.
20 Department of the Navy Certificate of Award for “Meritorious Civilian Service” that
21 was presented to him when he retired from civil service in 2008; and

22 **WHEREAS**, with an unprecedented service spanning twenty-five (25) years
23 and four (4) Governors, Mr. Pinauin holds the honor of having the most
24 reappointments in the history of the Guam Civil Service Commission. He was first

1 appointed to serve as a Civil Service Commissioner by Governor Joseph F. Ada in
2 February 1990, and he was reappointed over the years by Acting Governor Frank F.
3 Blas in May 1994, by Acting Governor Madeleine Z. Bordallo in April 2000, by
4 Governor Carl T.C. Gutierrez in February 2001, by Governor Felix P. Camacho in
5 April 2009, and by Governor Eddie Baza Calvo in January 2011; and

6 **WHEREAS**, as an individual who has truly gone above and beyond the call of
7 duty to excel in his career and give back to his community, Mr. Pinauin has made a
8 difference in the lives of many people with his dedication to public service; and

9 **WHEREAS**, on behalf of the people of this great island, *I Liheslaturan*
10 *Guåhan* joins the CSC and Mr. Pinauin's family in commemorating the many years of
11 scrupulous service and unwavering dedication that Mr. Pinauin has selflessly
12 bestowed upon the Commission, the government of Guam and its employees, and the
13 entire island community; now therefore, be it

14 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*
15 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
16 of Guam, commend and congratulate Mr. Manuel R. Pinauin on his retirement after
17 twenty-five (25) years of service with the Guam Civil Service Commission; and does
18 further express heartfelt appreciation and extend *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'àse'* to
19 Mr. Pinauin for the critical contributions he has made in the construction and
20 development of Guam and the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands (TTPI) as a
21 Construction Management Engineer with the Naval Facilities Engineering Command
22 (NAVFAC) for forty (40) years, and wish him well in his future endeavors; and be it

3 Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'låhen Guåhan*.


