1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***  
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN:***

3           **WHEREAS,** the Catholic Daughters of the Americas (CDA), “*Our Lady of*  
4 *Camarin Court No. 2047*” will observe the Forty-Fourth (44th) Local Charter

1 Anniversary of its Court, which was instituted on January 19, 1972 through the efforts  
2 of the late Archbishop Felixberto Flores and assisted by his aunt Emilia Long; and

3 **WHEREAS**, during the institution of the “*Our Lady of Camarin Court No.*  
4 *2047*,” at Saint Anthony Church in *Tamuning*, forty-five (45) ladies from Guam were  
5 present and are all considered Charter members. To date, only but a handful of the  
6 forty-five (45) Charter members are still surviving; and

7 **WHEREAS**, several of these ladies were instrumental in the institution of the  
8 second (2nd) Court on the island, the “*Maria Rainan Y Familia Court*” in *Tamuning*;  
9 and

10 **WHEREAS**, those Charter members that are now with this Court in *Tamuning*  
11 are former First Lady Lourdes Camacho, Florida Sanchez, Cerila Rapadas, and  
12 Dolores L.G. San Nicolas; and

13 **WHEREAS**, as for the “*Our Lady of Camarin Court No. 2047*,” we are  
14 sincerely pleased and grateful for the seven (7) Charter members who are still with our  
15 Court - Josefina Barcinas, Imelda Gines, Patricia T. Guerrero, the Honorable  
16 Congresswoman Madeleine Z. Bordallo, Josefina McDonald, Rosario S.N. Santos,  
17 and Virginia L.T. Unpingco; and

18 **WHEREAS**, under the leadership of the Reverend Monsignor Vicente T.  
19 Martinez, the organization's first Chaplain, and the late Mary Ropp, the first Regent  
20 installed in 1972, the “*Our Lady of Camarin Court No. 2047*” flourished by recruiting  
21 and helping to inspire succeeding Regents, namely, Florida Sanchez, Josephine  
22 Barcinas, Lourdes Camacho, Bennett San Agustin, Cerila Rapadas, Ana San Nicolas,  
23 Lourdes Camacho (2nd term), the late Elizabeth Arriola, Josephine McDonald,  
24 Josephine Barcinas (2nd term), Maria (Mae) Quinata, Pilar Lujan, Maria (Mae)  
25 Quinata (2nd term), Pilar Lujan (2nd term), Priscilla Muna, Elizabeth Untalan,  
26 Priscilla Muna (2nd term), Asuncion Cruz, Priscilla Muna (3rd term); and

1           **WHEREAS**, the Reverend Monsignor Vicente T. Martinez was succeeded by  
2 the Reverend Monsignor David I.A. Quitugua, and then followed by the current CDA  
3 Chaplain, the Reverend Monsignor Brigido Arroyo, and our island’s Spiritual Leader  
4 the Most Reverend Archbishop Anthony S. Apuron, O.F.M. Cap.; and

5           **WHEREAS**, the members of the Catholic Daughters of the Americas  
6 organization are dedicated to their Patroness, the Blessed Mother. Their mission is to  
7 embrace the principle of faith, working through love in the promotion of justice,  
8 equality, and advancement of human rights and human dignity for all; and

9           **WHEREAS**, bound together by its motto of “*Unity and Charity*,” the Catholic  
10 Daughters of the Americas is the largest Catholic women’s organization in the world  
11 dedicated to strengthening our spiritual life through Jesus Christ and his Church; and  
12 is organized in forty-four (44) states, Guam, Puerto Rico, the Dominican Republic,  
13 Mexico, and the Virgin Islands; and

14           **WHEREAS**, over the years, the “*Our Lady of Camarin Court No. 2047*” has  
15 expanded its membership beyond the forty-five (45) women that became members  
16 when it was first instituted; and


17           **WHEREAS**, the members of this organization have a historical and honorable  
18 tradition of service that benefits many who are victims of abuse, as well as the  
19 homeless and underprivileged; and its members dedicate the Court's 44<sup>th</sup> Year  
20 Anniversary, and many more days to come, to our Blessed Mother Mary for she is to  
21 each of us a model of Christian life and of what womanhood represents; now  
22 therefore, be it


23           **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*
