3            **WHEREAS, Janet D. Beldad graduated from North Salinas High School in**  
4 **January 1974; and**

1           **WHEREAS**, Janet began her government of Guam career serving with the  
2 Sixteenth (16<sup>th</sup>) Guam Legislature under Senator Peter F. Perez, where she worked as  
3 a Legal Aide Clerk / Secretary from 1980 to 1981; and

4           **WHEREAS**, Janet continued in her government of Guam career and on  
5 November 8, 1981, she started working with the Judiciary of Guam, as an Assistant  
6 Clerk II for then Presiding Judge Paul Abbate. Because of her outstanding service,  
7 she was promoted to serve in a newly created position, and was the first Electronic  
8 Court Reporter, where she worked from February 1982 to 1995; and

9           **WHEREAS**, Janet was ultimately moved to serve in the position of Courtroom  
10 Chamber Clerk in 1995 for the Honorable Katherine Maraman; and she then  
11 transferred to the Supreme Court in 2006 and worked as a Courtroom Chamber Clerk  
12 for Associate Justice Katherine Maraman; and

13           **WHEREAS**, during Janet’s tenure at the Judiciary, in addition to her regular  
14 assigned duties, she assisted and served with other Honorable Judges at the Judiciary  
15 of Guam from May 1986 to December 1991; and

16           **WHEREAS**, overall, Janet has made numerous personal sacrifices, and she has  
17 demonstrated commitment to her work by being loyal and faithful. She has dedicated  
18 many long hours during the week and on weekends to ensure that the court cases were  
19 calendared, docketed, or rescheduled, and that various incoming documents were set  
20 and sent out to be processed in a timely matter; and

21           **WHEREAS**, during her time in public service, Janet had diligently fulfilled her  
22 responsibilities by assisting with all matters of the Judicial Council as the Assistant  
23 Secretary, where she served from July 2008 to January 2016 under Chief Justice  
24 Robert Torres and former Chief Justice F. Philip Carbullido; and

25           **WHEREAS**, in 2011, Janet received a Certificate of Appreciation for thirty  
26 (30) years of faithful service; she was honored with the “Integrity Award” in

1 December 2010; and she was given an award for “Excellence in Court Operations” in  
2 December 2010; as well as being awarded with numerous Certificates of Recognition  
3 and Completion throughout her career; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Janet Beldad has ardently and efficiently fulfilled her public  
5 service, duties and obligations; and she will now enjoy her retirement spending more  
6 time with her family as she celebrates her retirement with her husband, Melvin  
7 Eustaquio Beldad; and their children: Tanielle Igros, JonDavid, and Kevin; now
