2 employed by the U.S. Naval Air Station, Guam as an Aircraft Firefighter, working  
3 from March 1979 to August 1991; and

5 career at the Judiciary of Guam serving as a Deputy Marshal. He received his  
6 Certificate in Basic Law Enforcement from the Guam Community College 34<sup>th</sup> Cycle

26 the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Melvin E.


