1 **WHEREAS**, the Latte Peace Festival was envisioned as an empowering
2 communal celebration of unity, diversity, collective strength and peace; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the Latte Peace Festival has become a significant event linked to
4 cultural education and exchange through the sharing of foods and the promoting of
5 cultural awareness; and

6 **WHEREAS**, international advocates for world peace, Dr. Daisaku Ikeda and
7 Mrs. Kaneko Ikeda, and other visiting dignitaries have been honored guests at the
8 Festival in accordance with promoting harmony and peace; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the California-based International Committee of Artists for Peace
10 (ICAP) has continued to provide support to the Latte Peace Festival since the
11 Festival's inception, further encouraging the belief in making art a vehicle for creating
12 peace; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Mayor Edna C. Tabanda of the Philippine city of
14 La Trinidad – sister city to *Tamuning-Tumon-Harmon* – and distinct members of their
15 community join the 4th Annual Latte Peace Festival to share their culture and
16 knowledge, as well as a most welcomed performance in the spirit of cultural
17 exchange; and


18 **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Mayor Arthur C. Baldo of the Philippine city of
19 Sablan – sister city to the village of *Agat* – and distinct members of their community
20 also join the 4th Annual Latte Peace Festival to share their culture and knowledge, and
21 also share a spirited performance as a most welcomed gesture of cultural exchange;

23 **WHEREAS**, the Latte Peace Festival will continue to plant the seeds of peace
24 and promote unity within our island community and with our neighbors, and celebrate
25 the culture of Guam and of those who call the island their home; now therefore, be it


1 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*
2 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
3 of Guam, observe the occasion of the 4th Annual Latte Peace Festival; and does
4 further commend and express gratitude to the people of the villages of *Tamuning*,
5 *Tumon*, and *Harmon*; the *Tamuning-Tumon-Harmon* Mayor's Office; and the
6 participants and organizers of the Latte Peace Festival, for hosting the Festival and

16 Philippines; and to the Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'låhen Guåhan*.


