1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***  
2           ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:**

3           **WHEREAS**, the late Victor Pangelinan Tabios was born on October 27, 1949,  
4           in the village of *Yona* and was raised in the village of *Sinajana*. He is the son of

1 †Pastor Taburda, †Veronica Balajadia Pangelinan and †Maria Perez Tuncap Tabios  
2 (*familian Korincho*); and

3 **WHEREAS**, Victor is survived by his loving wife of forty-four (44) years,  
4 Mary Ann Salas Tabios; and they are blessed with three (3) children: Joseph, †Jason,  
5 and Jayshabel; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Victor attended *Adelup* Elementary School, then went on to  
7 attend St. Jude Memorial Catholic School and George Washington High School; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Victor enlisted in the United States Army in 1967 at the young  
9 age of eighteen (18), and he served in the United States Army for twelve (12) years.  
10 He served honorably during a combat tour in the Vietnam War; and he is also a  
11 recipient of the Purple Heart medal; and

12 **WHEREAS**, after retiring from the United States Army in 1979, Victor worked  
13 at the U.S. Social Security Office, and he then served at the U.S. Naval Ship Repair  
14 Facility at Naval Station, Guam, where he worked as a welder. In 1990, he became  
15 fully retired as a Sheet Metal Mechanic because of medical reasons; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Victor will be remembered for his dedication and the giving of his  
17 personal time to help his fellow local Veterans; and he was committed to ensuring that  
18 all of Guam's men and women in uniform were recognized and appreciated; and


19 **WHEREAS**, Victor advocated for fee waivers for car registrations and drivers  
20 licenses for Veterans who are one hundred percent (100%) disabled. Another issue he  
21 was pushing for was to have a twenty-one (21) gun salute at the funeral services of  
22 100% Disabled Veterans; and


23 **WHEREAS**, after his retirement, Victor spent a lot of time with his family and  
24 friends, while always looking out for the needs of his fellow local Veterans. He also  
25 spent much of his time relaxing at his ranch in *Dededo* and raising pigs; and he loved  
26 spending time with his wife, Mary Ann; now therefore, be it
