- 3 WHEREAS, PenFed, also known as Pentagon Federal Credit Union, is a federal
- 4 credit union headquartered in Alexandria, Virginia, which is chartered and regulated

under the authority of the National Credit Union Administration (NCUA), and it is the
 nation's third largest federal credit union with assets of over 19 Billion Dollars as of
 November 2014, and with approximately 1.4 million members; and

WHEREAS, established in 1935, PenFed Credit Union today is one of the country's strongest and most stable financial institutions, serving members in all fifty (50) states and the District of Columbia, as well as on military bases in Guam, Puerto Rico and Okinawa; and PenFed Credit Union is federally insured by NCUA and an equal housing lender, and its services are available to members worldwide via the web seven (7) days a week, twenty-four (24) hours a day; and

WHEREAS, with a very humble beginning more than eighty (80) years ago,
PenFed Credit Union was established as the War Department Credit Union, starting off
with ten (10) members and forty (40) dollars in assets; and even as it grew in size
PenFed Credit Union managed to stay true to the ethos upon which the credit union
movement was founded - "people helping people"; and

WHEREAS, PenFed Credit Union members are the people who proudly and quietly take the field every day to serve their country and community; many who are actively employed by the military, state and local governments, government contractors and our nation's school systems; and many others who are simply hard-working Americans, playing by the rules, working day and night to build a better life for their families; and

WHEREAS, PenFed Credit Union members share two things: a belief in the American way of life, and a belief in themselves; therefore, PenFed Credit Union's mission isn't simply to help their members get by, but it exists to help them realize every ounce of their potential; and to educate, to encourage, and to usher its members dreams into the land of reality; this is why PenFed Credit Union strives to provide consistently best-in-class rates on car loans and home mortgages, and why its portfolio of award-winning credit cards offers incentives and innovative features that its
 competitors find hard to match; and

WHEREAS, PenFed Credit Union is among the few financial services 3 companies which specialize in serving the military; and it competes with other military 4 credit unions, such as the Navy Federal Credit Union, to include several large banks 5 6 like the Bank of America-Military Bank and USAA; and it has branches located in the Washington D.C. area, Hawaii, New York, North Carolina, and Texas; and military 7 bases in Guam, Japan, Portugal, and Puerto Rico. PenFed Credit Union operates three 8 9 (3) call centers, including Omaha, Nebraska; Eugene, Oregon; and Puerto Rico; and in 10 2003, it joined "Allpoint," a surcharge-free network of automated teller machines (ATM); and 11

WHEREAS, on Guam, PenFed Credit Union has enjoyed serving its many members at its Andersen Air Force Base location since the 1980s, and celebrates the recent branch opening in *Hagåtña*, as more Guamanians will be able to take advantage of PenFed Credit Union's leading financial products; and

WHEREAS, PenFed Credit Union's expansion demonstrates a real commitment to the people of Guam, but what has driven that point home is the fact that PenFed Credit Union has recently begun offering conforming mortgages for real estate on Guam. Homebuyers seeking properties on Guam can now finance up to Six Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$625,500) for conforming mortgages; therefore, all of Guam is now eligible for the financing of primary residences and second homes; and
