**Relative to expressing the full endorsement of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* for the initiative of the Government of Guam Association of Retired Persons, Incorporated, to apply for construction funding under the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority (GHURA) Community Development Block Grant Program, and other relevant local and federal funding programs, for the design and construction of its “*Manåmko*’ Legacy Center.”**

1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***  
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:**

3        **WHEREAS**, the Government of Guam Association of Retired Persons,  
4 Incorporated (GGARP) has served its members and the senior citizen population on  
5 Guam since its incorporation on May 20, 1969; and

1           **WHEREAS**, the Government of Guam Association of Retired Persons,  
2 Incorporated, is one of the oldest and most recognized local non-profit organizations;  
3 and

4           **WHEREAS**, the Government of Guam Association of Retired Persons,  
5 Incorporated, was founded to improve the moral, mental, social and general welfare of  
6 all Government of Guam retirees and senior citizens; and

7           **WHEREAS**, the Government of Guam Association of Retired Persons,  
8 Incorporated, has promoted the work and success of Guam’s retirees, ensuring the  
9 promotion of their contributions to our island’s history; and

10           **WHEREAS**, in 1989, the Government of Guam Association of Retired  
11 Persons, Incorporated, pursuant to Public Law 19-56, obtained real estate from the  
12 government of Guam (Lot No. 86-2 in the municipality of *Agaña*, containing an area  
13 of six thousand (6,000) square meters) to build its clubhouse to facilitate various  
14 programs and services for the *manâmkô*’ who call Guam their home; and

15           **WHEREAS**, the Government of Guam Association of Retired Persons,  
16 Incorporated, had served as the managing center of Guam’s twelve (12) Senior Citizen  
17 Centers for many years until 2013, bringing much needed support to all of the senior  
18 population in coordinating various services such as meals, physical exercise, bingo,  
19 island-wide outings, *Manâmkô*’ Talent Showcases and Senior Citizens’ Band to name  
20 a few; and

21           **WHEREAS**, the Government of Guam Association of Retired Persons,  
22 Incorporated, envisions an expansion of its facility with the construction of a  
23 “*Manâmkô*’ Legacy Center” and renovations to its existing building “A”; and

24           **WHEREAS**, the Government of Guam Association of Retired Persons,  
25 Incorporated, has commenced its search for the funding of construction, and

1 specifically intends to submit a grant application to the Guam Housing and Urban  
2 Renewal Authority under the Community Development Block Grant Program; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the Government of Guam Association of Retired Persons,  
4 Incorporated, has approved its application through the adoption of Government of  
5 Guam Association of Retired Persons, Incorporated, Board of Directors Resolution  
6 No. 2015-02; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the Government of Guam Association of Retired Persons,  
8 Incorporated, has received the support of the Mayor and Municipal Planning Council  
9 of the municipality of the capitol city of *Hagåtña* through the adoption of *Hagåtña*  
10 Municipal Planning Council Resolution No. 2015-01; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the Government of Guam Association of Retired Persons,  
12 Incorporated, has further received the endorsement through Chamorro Land Trust  
13 Commission Resolution No. 2009-03 of the request by the GGARP for the Guam  
14 Legislature to transfer to its organization a portion of Lot 86-R2, containing an area of  
15 1.5 acres, municipality of *Agaña*, and to be consolidated with Lot 86-2, municipality  
16 of *Agaña*, subject to the survey for the said purposes of the multi-generational facility;  
17 and


18 **WHEREAS**, the Government of Guam Association of Retired Persons,  
19 Incorporated, seeks the support of the Government of Guam for the planning and  
20 construction of the “*Manâmkô*’ Legacy Center”; now therefore, be it


21 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina’Trentai Tres Na*

11 Urban Renewal Authority; and to the Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga’låhen*  
12 *Guåhan*.
