1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN***  
2 ***GUÅHAN*:**  
3           **WHEREAS, Dylan Pinaula Naputi is the eldest son of Vincent and Elaine**  
4 **Naputi from the beautiful village of *Malojloj*; and is the younger brother of D'Ana and**  
5 **older brother of Xavier; and**

1           **WHEREAS**, Dylan began playing soccer at the young age of four (4) years old.  
2 Dylan’s self-discipline, his self-motivation, and his devotion as an athlete continues to  
3 inspire his coaches, his family, his friends, the youth and the community; and

4           **WHEREAS**, Dylan has always strived to be the finest athlete he can be, and he  
5 has committed many hours of training and has sacrificed to succeed in every sport he  
6 has played. He has competed stateside and internationally; and he exhibits motivation  
7 for himself and for others while offering his time to train others to become more  
8 skilled athletes; and

9           **WHEREAS**, at the age of eight (8), Dylan decided to play multiple sports  
10 during the season: soccer and football, soccer and baseball, and back to soccer. At the  
11 age of nine (9), he decided to play for the Babe Ruth Rookie Baseball League while  
12 still playing soccer because soccer held a definite significance for him. Being that it  
13 was his first time as a young boy to ever play the sport of baseball, Dylan did very  
14 well; and, after trying out for the All-Stars, he was selected to represent Guam in the  
15 Pacific Regional Tournament in California in 2004; and

16           **WHEREAS**, in 2005 after relocating to Boise, Idaho, Dylan devoted all his  
17 focus to playing soccer and improving his soccer skills. He played competitive soccer  
18 and helped his U13 team to win a championship in its division. He also attended a  
19 speed school, which assisted him in bettering his agility and lateral movement,  
20 strength, and self-confidence; and

21           **WHEREAS**, in 2009, Dylan and his family returned to Guam to care for his ill  
22 grandfather. At the age of fourteen (14), Dylan tried out and was selected to play for  
23 the U15 Guam National Team. Additionally, he played baseball and football for  
24 George Washington High School (GWHS). At the age of sixteen (16), Dylan was  
25 called up to the Guam Men’s “*Matao*” National Team while still a student at GWHS,

1 and he scored three (3) international goals before his high school graduation in 2013;  
2 and

3 **WHEREAS**, Dylan played in numerous international tournaments while  
4 playing on the Men’s National Team, such as Guam against American Samoa at the  
5 2011 South Pacific Games in New Caledonia, and Guam against Chinese Taipei in the  
6 2012 East Asian Cup in Hong Kong; as well as against Macao in the 2012 Philippine  
7 Peace Cup in Manila, Philippines; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Dylan knew that being on the Guam Men’s National Team was  
9 going to be challenging as a high school student. Traveling two (2) to three (3) times  
10 a year participating in off-island tournaments was a struggle to catch up on make-up  
11 work and exams, but he pulled through and maintained his grades. Dylan graduated  
12 from high school in June 2013, and he subsequently attended his freshman year of  
13 college at the University of Guam; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Dylan is on the *Matao* roster for Guam’s upcoming series of  
15 matches in the 2018 FIFA World Cup Russia Qualifiers and the AFC Asian Cup UAE  
16 2019 Joint Qualification Round 2; and

17 **WHEREAS**, in January 2016, Dylan was officially called to play  
18 professionally with the Ventura County Fusion Soccer Team in the Southwest  
19 Division of the U.S. Premier Development League’s (PDL) Western Conference; and


20 **WHEREAS**, throughout his journey as a soccer player, Dylan was fortunate to  
21 have a lot of love and support from his family and close friends. He is a very humble  
22 and loving young man, devoted to his family and faith. He is not one to revel in the  
23 limelight, but he would rather show humility in representing our island of Guam and  
24 his family. Dylan will continue on with his dedication and efforts to achieve his dream  
25 to reach the level of a Professional Player. There is a quote that aspires him to strive  
26 for the best: “*Hard work beats talent, when talent refuses to work hard.*” He knows


1 that in everything he pursues, it will require hard work to get there; now therefore, be
