1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** from 1996 to the present time, Matson has provided a vital lifeline
4 to the economies of Hawaii, Alaska, Guam, Micronesia, and selected south Pacific

1 islands, and has operated a premium, expedited service from China to Southern
2 California; and

3 **WHEREAS**, on February 1, 1996, Matson established its Guam office and
4 provided weekly service to Guam and the CNMI, and bi-weekly service to the
5 surrounding Micronesia Islands. Over the past four (4) years, Matson has been the only
6 container carrier servicing Guam, and it has provided continuous uninterrupted services
7 since its inception; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Matson has made numerous contributions to the various island
9 communities throughout Micronesia through the *Matson Foundation* with an estimated
10 monetary contribution for 2016 of over Two Hundred Thirty-eight Thousand Dollars
11 (\$238,000); and

12 **WHEREAS**, Matson has taken a leadership role in promoting “green” initiatives
13 in our business and community service with activities like the *Adahi I Tano’* Program.
14 The Program began in 2013 and, to date, more than five (5) dozen different non-profit
15 organizations on Guam have conducted close to eighty (80) cleanups that have benefited
16 our environment while earning money for their good causes. Matson has appreciated
17 working with so many deserving local organizations; and


18 **WHEREAS**, through the *Adahi I Tano’* program, Matson donates the use of
19 container equipment on Guam for environmental cleanup projects arranged by non-
20 profit organizations and pays for the trucking expenses incurred in the delivery and
21 pickup of the container. Then, the non-profit organizations that successfully complete
22 a cleanup receive a Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) cash contribution from Matson
23 Guam; now therefore, be it


24 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*

26 of Guam, commend and congratulate Matson Guam on its twenty (20) years of


1 dedicated service to Guam; and does further extend a warm and sincere *Un Dangkolo*
