1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** the Association of Government Accountants (AGA) is a
4 professional organization with a network of fifteen thousand (15,000) members in
5 over one hundred (100) chapters across the United States and around the world,
6 representing state, federal, and local governments, and private accountability
7 professionals; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the AGA, Guam Chapter has one hundred ninety-one (191)
2 members who work to uphold AGA’s mission of “Advancing Government
3 Accountability” through its educational efforts while emphasizing high standards of
4 conduct, honor, and character in its Code of Ethics; and who are making significant
5 advances, in both professional ability and service to the residents of Guam, by
6 mastering increasingly technical and complex accounting requirements; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the Certified Government Financial Manager (CGFM) Program
8 of AGA demonstrates professionalism and competency by requiring that CGFM
9 candidates, twenty-four (24) of which are from the AGA, Guam Chapter, have
10 appropriate education and professional experience; abide by AGA’s Code of Ethics;
11 pass three (3) examinations requiring expertise in governmental environment,
12 governmental financial management and control, and governmental accounting,
13 financial reporting and budgeting; and maintain their certification by completing at
14 least eighty (80) hours of continuing professional education in government financial
15 management topics or related technical subjects every two (2) years; and


16 **WHEREAS**, the AGA, Guam Chapter is led by Mr. Artemio “Ricky”
17 Hernandez, CGFM-AGA President; Mr. Jose Guevara III, CGFM-AGA Director and
18 Certification Regional Coordinator for the AGA-Pacific Rim; and Ms. Doreen
19 Crisostomo, Ph.D., CGFM-AGA Senior Vice President, Section II; and

20 **WHEREAS**, these dedicated individuals lead a passionate group of people in
21 the government financial management profession, which is characterized by its efforts
22 to achieve common objectives and by its observance of certain fundamental
23 principles; and the CGFM-AGA members must adhere to ethical requirements to
24 ensure the highest quality of performance, and to maintain public confidence in the
25 accounting profession; now therefore, be it


1 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*
