WHEREAS, hemophilia is a hereditary disease of the blood, occurring primarily in males, in which a vital clotting protein called factor VIII is either inactive or completely missing, thereby causing significant delay in blood clotting, frequent bleeding and hemorrhages, and damages to joints; and

WHEREAS, Von Willebrand's Disease is a congenital and/or acquired bleeding disorder in which a protein called Von Willebrand factor is either lacking or impaired, thereby affecting proper blood clotting; and is characteristic of nose bleeds, gum bleeds, easy bruising, and heavy menstrual periods; and

WHEREAS, the GCHCP is held accountable by the Western States/Federal
Treatment Centers/Region IX in reporting on the demographics, diagnoses, and health
care utilization of its patients for best practices and research outcomes, and the

distribution of the National Patient Satisfaction Surveys each year; and

WHEREAS, in 2014, there were a total of fifty-seven (57) patients diagnosed as being Hemophilia A, Hemophilia B, Hemophilia gene carriers, Von Willebrand's Disease, Hageman Factor XII, and a clotting disorder listed in the Guam Hemophilia Patient Registry; and

WHEREAS, the GCHCP is committed to providing quality care to our hemophilia patients and their families by holding monthly clinics at the Northern Region Community Health Center; by conducting Medical Symposiums to provide updates on hemophilia care and other bleeding disorders; and by conducting family educational and recreational camps; and
