3 **WHEREAS, on June 22, 1984, the University of Santo Tomas Alumni**
4 **Organization of Guam (USTAOG) was incorporated with seven (7) members of a**
5 **Board of Directors: Dr. Marciano Santos, Dr. Ruben Basilio, Dr. Luis Arguelles, Dr.**

1 Eddie Del Rosario, Attorney Cesar Alegria, Mr. Ging Baquisal, and Mr. Emelio Uy;
2 along with the Founding Officers: President Joe Guevara, Vice-President Marciano
3 Santos, Secretary Sally Aquino, Treasurer Claudia Gaspard, and Auditor Jaime
4 Rimpo; and

5 **WHEREAS**, for over thirty (30) years, the USTAOG has fulfilled many
6 community outreach programs by providing contributions to the Guam and the
7 Filipino communities, to include projects in the area of health care. With its
8 tremendous spirit of volunteerism, the USTAOG has brought immeasurable
9 humanitarian efforts through coordinating free medical services and monetary support
10 for disaster victims in the Philippines, as well as extending assistance to various
11 charities on Guam; and

12 **WHEREAS**, the various charitable projects that have promoted the goodwill
13 spirit of the University of Santo Tomas (UST) alumni include: conducting medical
14 missions to help the residents of Gill Baza, Swamp Road, Harmon Industrial Park, and
15 Hemlani Apartments in Harmon; feeding the homeless through *Kamalen Karidat*;
16 annual donations to the St. Dominic Senior Care Home in *Barrigada*; scholarship
17 awards to indigent and deserving Guam students (in 2014, it awarded Five Hundred
18 Dollars (\$500.00) each to two (2) deserving students attending UOG); co-organizer of
19 the annual conference of the Guam Diabetes Association; monetary donations to the
20 Philippine Red Cross in the aftermath of the disaster and calamities caused by
21 Supertyphoon Yolanda, and the strong earthquake; monetary donations to the UST
22 Office of Alumni Relations in Manila, Philippines, in support of its community
23 project, "*Simbahayan*"; the donation of tarps and goods to the Chuuk typhoon victims;
24 monetary donations to the Saipan typhoon victims; medical missions to help the less

1 fortunate and the homeless people of Guam, which was held at Catholic Social
2 Services, in cooperation with the Guam Homeless Coalition, the University of Guam,
3 and the Guam Nurses Association, where USTAOG members provided free medical
4 consultations, medications, immunizations, clothes, toys and books to the homeless
5 residents of Guam; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the USTAOG also donated Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) and
7 toiletries to the St. Dominic Senior Care Home; it supported the first UST community
8 outreach program called “CREDO” (Certificate on Religious Education Distance-
9 Learning Online) in Guam, of which seven (7) Guam participants graduated at St.
10 Anthony Catholic Church; it donated Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) to the Guam
11 Diabetes Association (a non-profit Guam organization which promotes diabetes
12 awareness in Guam); it hosted the UST Taekwondo Varsity Team when they visited
13 Guam; and it donated One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) to its alma mater, the
14 University of Santo Tomas, for its different programs, to include the Student Mobility
15 Fund, the UST *Simbayahan* Community Development Program, and the UST Hospital
16 Clinical and Charity Ward; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the USTAOG holds its annual induction of officers and board
18 members to induct the new officers who will uphold the responsibility of a Thomasian
19 to commit their involvement, to implement the various talents and skills they have
20 learned, and to maintain the mission to continue to achieve and implement community
21 services, and to always instill all its endeavors, not for just the alumni, but for our
22 families, our community, and our island; and

1 **WHEREAS**, through the hard work and the future plans of the USTAOG,
2 many challenges still await; and it is time for the outgoing members to continue their
3 work through other dedicated Thomasians like them; and
