1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**  
2        ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3        **WHEREAS, 2016 marks the 48<sup>th</sup> anniversary of UOG's Charter and the 64<sup>th</sup>**  
4        **anniversary of the founding of the UOG, which was established in 1952 as the Territorial**  
5        **College of Guam, and renamed as the University of Guam in 1968; and**

1           **WHEREAS**, since its founding, UOG has conferred over sixteen thousand  
2 (16,000) degrees to students who serve as the foundation of our island's and region's  
3 professional workforce, and who strengthen our economy as they establish themselves in  
4 businesses and in the community as accountants, scientists, nurses, teachers,  
5 entrepreneurs, social workers, and many other specialties; and

6           **WHEREAS**, UOG alumni maintain a strong, vibrant presence in all sectors of our  
7 community and play a major role in the political, economic, and social development of  
8 our region; and

9           **WHEREAS**, UOG, as the only four (4)-year, U.S. accredited, land-grant  
10 institution in the Western Pacific, is a public, comprehensive university offering thirteen  
11 (13) master degree programs and thirty-one (31) bachelor degree programs; and

12           **WHEREAS**, UOG achieved an unprecedented eight (8)-year accreditation by the  
13 Western Association of Schools and Colleges Senior Commission (WASC) in 2009, and  
14 program-specific accreditation from the Accreditation Commission for Education in  
15 Nursing, Inc. for the Nursing program; the Council on Social Work Education for the  
16 Social Work program; the National Council for the Accreditation of Teacher Education  
17 for the Education programs; and the International Assembly for Collegiate Business  
18 Education for the Business Administration programs; and

19           **WHEREAS**, UOG is committed to academic quality as evidenced by its  
20 accreditation from these nationally recognized accrediting bodies; and its academic  
21 programs, and its research units are nationally and internationally recognized for their  
22 scholarly work and contributions to the community and the region; and

23           **WHEREAS**, the WASC accreditation team, in its November 12, 2015 Offsite  
24 Review Summary, commended the University for its Good to Great Initiative, its fiscal  
25 stewardship, its ongoing enrollment growth, its focus on and commitment to regional  
26 needs and the public good through education, research and service; and its exceptional

1 pursuit and attainment of its first year retention goals and response to the needs of the  
2 most at-risk students, with specific attention to various indigenous Pacific islanders; and

3 **WHEREAS**, UOG’s enrollment has grown an average of one point eighty-eight  
4 percent (1.88%) over the last five (5) years reaching a high of three thousand nine hundred  
5 ninety-one (3,991) students for the Fall 2015 semester; and UOG managed a complex  
6 array of over one hundred ten (110) grants and contracts of over Thirty-five Million  
7 Dollars in Fiscal Year 2015; and

8 **WHEREAS**, UOG and the UOG Endowment Foundation have launched an  
9 aggressive capital campaign plan designed to provide the financial support necessary to  
10 build a 21<sup>st</sup> Century campus that offers physical facilities that enable UOG students,  
11 faculty, staff and visitors to engage in UOG’s mission, “*Ina, Diskubre, Setbe – To*  
12 *Enlighten, To Discover, To Serve*” utilizing up-to-date technology and resources; and

13 **WHEREAS**, this year’s 2016 Charter Day theme, “Triton Spirit: One University,  
14 Many Voices,” recognizes the globalization of the University community to include local,  
15 regional and international students, faculty, and areas of study and research; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Robert A. Underwood, Ed.D., UOG President, appointed the 2016  
17 Charter Day Committee to organize this year’s activities, whose membership includes:

8 be it further


