1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI TRES NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** the Honorable Alberto A.C. Lamorena V, affectionately known
4 as “Tony,” was born on February 22, 1955; and is the son of the late Honorable
5 Alberto T. Lamorena, Guam attorney and former Senator, and the late Fe Untalan
6 Cristobal Lamorena; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Alberto A.C. Lamorena V is married to the
2 former Elisa Lucero; and they have two (2) sons, Justin and Anthony; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Alberto A.C. Lamorena V is a graduate of John
4 F. Kennedy High School; and he pursued his higher education at the University of
5 Guam and at The Brooks Institute of Photographic Art and Science in Santa
6 Barbara, California, where he earned his Bachelor of Arts Degree in Art; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Alberto A.C. Lamorena V spent much of his life
8 and career promoting the Arts and Humanities having held such positions as Gallery
9 Coordinator for the Insular Arts Council, Chairman and Charter Member of the
10 Micronesian Seafaring Society, Founding Member of the Board of Directors of the
11 Guam Humanities Council, Chairman of the Consortium for the Pacific Arts and
12 Culture, member of the Board of Directors of the National Assembly of State Arts
13 Agencies, and Executive Director of the Guam Council on the Arts and Humanities
14 Agency; and

15 **WHEREAS**, as the Executive Director of the Guam Council on the Arts and
16 Humanities Agency, the Honorable Alberto A.C. Lamorena V was instrumental in
17 implementing the “Percent in the Arts Program,” the Guam Art Bank, the *Gef Pa’go*,
18 and other programs that perpetuated the Chamorro culture; and

19 **WHEREAS**, in addition to his extensive work in promoting the Arts and
20 Humanities, the Honorable Alberto A.C. Lamorena V recognized early in his
21 career that the best work in life is service to the people, and he well and
22 faithfully served the people of Guam as both a civic leader and a public servant;
23 and

24 **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Alberto A.C. Lamorena V fulfilled his civic
25 responsibilities in various capacities and notably demonstrated his leadership
26 capabilities while serving as President of the Paradise Chapter of the Jaycees

1 International, as a member of the Board of Directors of the Guam Chapter of the
2 American Red Cross, as President of the *Guåhan* Scholarship Foundation, and as
3 President of Helping Instruct the Arts Foundation; and he spearheaded the Adopt an
4 Athlete program for the Guam Special Olympics; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Alberto A.C. Lamorena V has had a
6 distinguished career in government service having held leadership positions, both
7 appointed and elected, in both the executive and legislative branches of the
8 government of Guam; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Alberto A.C. Lamorena V was elected by the
10 people of Guam to serve as a Senator in the 23rd, 24th, and 25th Guam
11 Legislatures during which time he served as the Majority Whip and as
12 Chairman of the Committee on Tourism, Economic Development and Cultural
13 Affairs; and

14 **WHEREAS**, during his tenure as Senator, Tony authored numerous laws,
15 including the creation of the Guam Waterworks Authority (GWA) from the former
16 Public Utility Agency of Guam (PUAG); the creation of the *Tiyan* Trust that would
17 have provided an avenue for economic development and equitable compensation for
18 the original *Tiyan* landowners and their heirs; the implementation of the captive
19 insurance industry and e-commerce; the lease of the *Oka Point* properties that would
20 generate revenue to install infrastructure on Chamorro Land Trust Commission lands;
21 and numerous other pieces of legislation that promoted the growth of tourism on
22 Guam; and

23 **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Alberto A.C. Lamorena V's demonstrated
24 leadership, abilities, and commitment were recognized by several government of
25 Guam boards and commissions, and three (3) governors of Guam who, at various
26 times in his career, appointed him to serve in various positions of leadership, such as

1 Director of the Guam Council on the Arts and Humanities Agency; General Manager
2 of the Guam Visitors Bureau (GVB), where he implemented marketing campaigns
3 that improved and maintained visitor arrival numbers that were impacted by
4 Supertyphoon *Pongsona* and the SARS virus, and programs that promoted the
5 Chamorro culture in Guam's various visitor markets; Acting Administrator of the
6 Guam Economic Development Authority; Senior Advisor to the Governor of Guam;
7 Director of the Bureau of Statistics and Plans, where he led the way for the 2010
8 Census, and the Northern and Central Land Use Plan, and oversaw the Civilian-
9 Military Task Force; Special Assistant to the Governor of Guam; and Executive
10 Director of the Civil Service Commission; and

11 **WHEREAS**, some of the notable achievements of the Honorable Alberto
12 A.C. Lamorena V in his capacity as Executive Director of the Civil Service
13 Commission include the completion the Personnel Action Review rules, and the
14 Administrative Law Judge rules currently in the final phase of the Administrative
15 Adjudication Act process; being proactive in providing training and development to
16 Commissioners, the Governor's Cabinet members and the general public; being
17 instrumental in securing the passage of legislation to provide for an Administrative
18 Law Judge which would enhance the Commission's ability to adjudicate matters
19 expeditiously and reduce the Commission's backlog of cases significantly; providing
20 motivation to the Commission's staff to excel which contributed to the numerous
21 awards won by the Commission through the Governor's Mag Pro Employee
22 Recognition Program from 2011 through 2015; and

23 **WHEREAS**, on March 8, 2016, after a long and fruitful career of exemplary
24 public service to the people of Guam, the Honorable Alberto A.C. Lamorena V
25 will retire from government service; now therefore, be it


1 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*

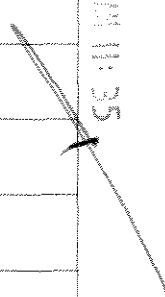
