24 makes time for anyone in need; and


25 **WHEREAS**, every day, Jannica faces the challenge of trying to fully balance

4 effort should not be undermined; now therefore, be it


5 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Tres Na*

16 Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'låhen Guåhan*.


