- 3 WHEREAS, Reverend Father Michael William Cruz Crisostomo,
- 4 affectionately known as Påle' Mike, is a native born priest of Guam who was

ordained as a priest nineteen (19) years ago. He attended Catholic schools throughout

2 his life that nurtured his vocation to the priesthood; and he later earned degrees in

Humanities with a concentration in Psychology and a Masters of Divinity; and

WHEREAS, *Påle*' Mike has served on several boards of non-profit organizations, such as the Make-a-Wish Foundation of Guam, Erica's House of Hope Foundation, the Guam Cancer Coalition, the Health Services of the Pacific, and the IMAGINE Guam Commission. He was also appointed to serve on the Governor's Pardon Review Board and the Criminal Injuries Compensation Commission by Governor Felix Camacho and Governor Eddie Baza Calvo; and

WHEREAS, *Påle'* Mike is the program director for Micronesian Solutions. The Archdiocese of *Agaña* and the Immaculate Heart of Mary Church have joined in the efforts to provide a resource and training center for domestic violence and sexual assault survivors, and extend outreach awareness to local communities, ethnic cultural populations, and faith-based congregations. The center serves as a beacon of hope for victims of domestic violence and sexual assault on the island and develops training programs for faith and community-based leaders to identify, support and fund events and activities that would bring an end to violence in our families and homes. Micronesian Solutions has been working with the Chuukese community in providing training on domestic violence and sexual assault and expanding their knowledge of the different service providers on our island. He has also been entrusted to serve as the Pastor of the parish of the Immaculate Heart of Mary Catholic Church in the village of *Toto*; and

WHEREAS, *Påle*' Mike is currently serving as the Chairperson of the Guam Coalition against Sexual Assault and Family Violence (GCASAFV), the Vice-Chairperson of Victims' Advocates Reaching Out (VARO), and an assistant Chaplain of the Guam Police Department (GPD). With his work experiences and intense

training in the areas of violence and abuse, suicide and assault, *Påle*' Mike brings to

the discussion and dialogue a unique perspective as a clergy member and as a victim

3 survivor; and

WHEREAS, *Påle*' Mike has worked tirelessly in the Guam community to help raise awareness of the dangers of family violence and to promote peaceful resolutions of conflicts. He has freely spoken at conferences and community events about his sister's and niece's death which was a result of family violence. He has also helped to raise awareness of the effects on remaining family members. His testimony is powerful and is supported by his community work in this area; and

WHEREAS, the beneficiaries of *Påle*' Mike's time and effort is the community of Guam. He has spread awareness regarding domestic violence, sexual assault, and suicide. He has many accomplishments relative to social work and to serving Guam's community; and with his love and passion for helping others and spreading awareness, his positions serving in various non-profit organizations has encompassed what a great community leader he is; now therefore, be it
