3 **WHEREAS, Mr. Craig Burns moved to Guam three (3) years ago and has**
4 **immersed himself in the community where he is involved in multiple projects that**
5 **support island sustainability. With an extensive background in social work and**
6 **military services, he is able to apply his experience to our small community while**
7 **respecting the uniqueness of our island; and**

1 **WHEREAS**, Craig is a hard working parent and husband, who always looks
2 out for the betterment of his family. Craig and his family have embraced Guam as
3 their home, and his work reflects his commitment to the community. He challenges
4 the status quo, but does so with empathy and humility. He has developed positive
5 working relationships with a wide variety of organizations and island leaders across
6 the entire political spectrum; and his obvious passion for the well-being of Guam and
7 of people in general shows through in everything he does; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Craig conducts presentations focused on culturally responsive
9 community development in several conferences. He continues to serve as a Practicum
10 Instructor to Master's of Social Work students from the University of Hawaii at
11 Manoa, and he is currently an adjunct faculty at the University of Guam (UOG)
12 Division of Social Work; and


13 **WHEREAS**, Craig continues to share his passion and knowledge on gardening
14 and sustainability through participation in the New Farmer Training at UOG, both as
15 part of the organizing committee and as a participant. He volunteers as part of the
16 Non-Communicable Disease Consortium (NCD), One Community Guam (with the
17 U.S. Attorney's Office), and offers his expertise to other community organizations
18 committed to serving veterans and encouraging island sustainability; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Craig is the current President of the National Association of
20 Social Workers (NASW), Guam Chapter, where his term as President began on July 1,
21 2015. Through Craig's leadership and during his first six (6) months as President, he
22 accomplished one of his goals of increasing chapter membership to over one hundred
23 (100) members. This sixty-three percent (63%) increase in membership is the largest
24 increase of any social work chapter in the nation; and it has always been the goal of
25 the Chapter to increase its membership since its inception, and this goal was achieved;
