- 3 WHEREAS, Siñot Eddie Leon Guerrero Benavente, also known as "Ed," was
- 4 born on August 4, 1956, in the village of *Tamuning*; and is a resident of the village of
- 5 Mangilao; and

1 WHEREAS, Siñot Eddie Leon Guerrero Benavente is the son of Dolores Leon 2 Guerrero (familian Lale') and Christobal Benavente (familian Chedu); and has five (5) 3 brothers and two (2) sisters; and WHEREAS, Siñot Eddie Leon Guerrero Benavente is married to Julie 4 5 Quichocho-Benavente; and they are blessed with two (2) daughters, Amber Benavente-6 Sanchez and Tasi Quichocho Benavente; and five (5) grandchildren, Ha'ani Benavente-Sanchez, Sinahi Benavente-Sanchez, Na'ina Benavente, Rai Benavente-Sanchez, and 7 8 Nina'i-Fu'una Benavente-Sanchez; and 9 WHEREAS, Siñot Eddie Leon Guerrero Benavente graduated from the Guam Vocational Technical High School with a focus on electrical studies. He received his 10 11 Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice from the University of Guam, and his Chamoru Teaching Degree in Secondary Education from the Chamorro Teaching 12 13 Degree Institute (CTDI) of the University of Guam; and 14 WHEREAS, Siñot Eddie Leon Guerrero Benavente had served under Senator Madeleine Mary Zeien Bordallo, where he assisted constituents with legislative issues 15 and conducted legal research and drafted proposed legislations; and 16 17 WHEREAS, Siñot Eddie Leon Guerrero Benavente produced the Chamoru Talk Show, "Programan Konbetsasion," on KUAM radio, from 1989 to 1992, to discuss the 18 19 pressing issues of the *Chamoru* people and to provide a forum for those concerns at the 20 time; and 21 WHEREAS, starting in 1993, Siñot Eddie Leon Guerrero Benavente taught 22 Chamoru language for a decade at the Department of Education, where he not only educated young individuals in the Chamoru language, but fully immersed them in the 23

culture of the Chamoru people through song, oral history, and the written word; and

WHEREAS, along with the late Senator Angel Leon Guerrero Santos, Siñot 1 2 Eddie Leon Guerrero Benavente led the movement for the implementation of the Chamorro Land Trust Act of 1975; and 3 WHEREAS, Siñot Eddie Leon Guerrero Benavente subsequently served as I 4 5 Maga'lahi of I Nasion Chamoru, from 1995 to 2003; and is currently a contributing 6 member of I Nasion Chamoru, which is devoted to advocating for indigenous rights, 7 decolonization, and unity among the Chamoru people; and 8 WHEREAS, Siñot Eddie Leon Guerrero Benavente was the first Chamoru to 9 receive membership to the prestigious Alston-Bannerman Fellow for Leaders of Color, a program founded in 1988 to honor and support longtime activists of color; and 10 11 WHEREAS, Siñot Eddie Leon Guerrero Benavente served as Executive Director of the Commission on Decolonization of the government of Guam, where he educated 12 13 others and promoted Chamoru decolonization and self-determination at various events, 14 workshops and seminars organized by the United Nations; and 15 WHEREAS, Siñot Eddie Leon Guerrero Benavente served the people and 16 landowners of Guam as the Executive Director of the Guam Ancestral Lands 17 Commission, which is tasked with transferring the land titles from the federal 18 government to the government of Guam, and ultimately to the original landowners; and 19 WHEREAS, Siñot Eddie Leon Guerrero Benavente continues to promote and 20 perpetuate the Chamoru culture as an organizer at Sagan Kotturan Chamoru (Chamoru 21 Cultural Center), a center for cultural education where he provides lessons in weaving, 22 the *Chamoru* language, and *Chamoru* history; now therefore, be it 23 **RESOLVED,** that the Committee on Rules of I Mina'Trentai Tres Na 24 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the people 25 of Guam, recognize and honor Siñot Eddie Leon Guerrero Benavente for his dedication 26 and commitment to the preservation and perpetuation of the Chamoru culture and

- language as we celebrate *Mes Chamoru* 2016; and does further commend him for his
- 2 lifetime of dedication to self-determination, and for his continued leadership and service
- 3 to I Nasion Chamoru and the people of Guam; and be it further
